Agenda Item: KDE Mathematics Information and Update (4:42 p.m. ET)

Summary of Discussion: The facilitators shared information about mathematics initiatives taking place at the Kentucky Department of Education. This included information about the Mathematics Achievement Fund (MAF) and support around high-quality instructional resources.

Agenda Item: Review CMA Strategic Plan (4:48 p.m. ET)

Presenters: Erin Chavez and Jenny Bay-Williams

Summary of Discussion: Erin Chavez facilitated a discussion around the CMA strategic plan. The discussion focused on things that were already being done in the state and things that were still needed. Instructional coaching was lifted up as a need. Discussion included the value of high-quality instructional materials and the need for effective teaching practices in supporting teacher retention and improved achievement. Improving mathematics identities was mentioned as a goal that would contribute to mathematics achievement, beyond test scores. This was echoed from the adult education perspective in how learners feel shame and fear of making mistakes.
