

## Notice: KDE Web Applications Login Update Planned for June 25

As of noon eastern time on Friday, June 25, the KDE login page, (<https://applications.education.ky.gov/login>), will be updated to improve security and to minimize the number of passwords to keep track of. Users with a valid district or KDE email account will be switched to using their email address and password for accessing the Web applications listed below. This change only affects users with KDE or district email accounts – There is no change for users without a district or KDE email account. The applications listed below will be unavailable the morning of June 25 from 8AM ET – Noon ET while being updated.

1. Sign in with your KDE Web Account username and password as you normally do as shown on the **left hand side of the screen:**

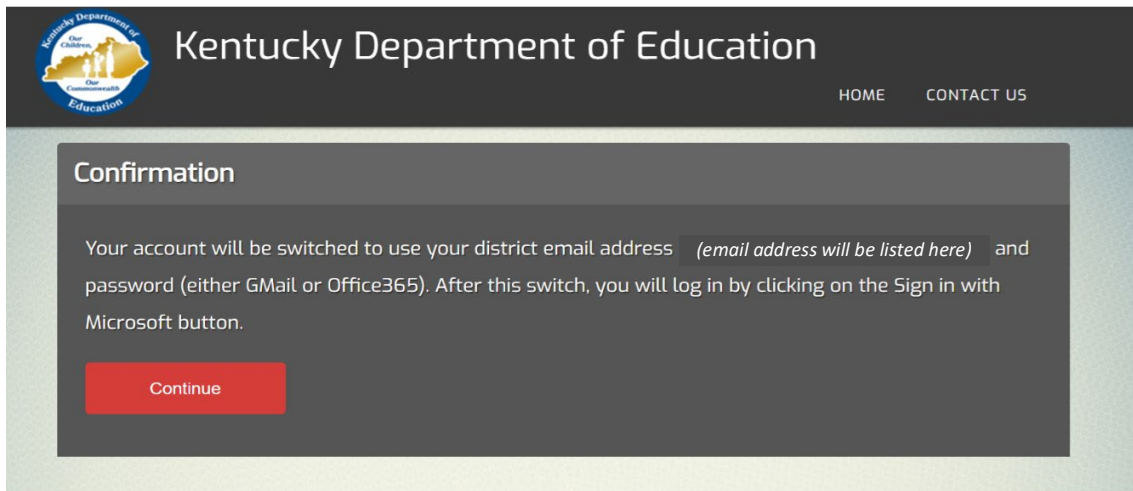

2. If you have a valid district or KDE email address, you will be presented with the following - Click on the, "Continue", button.



3. If your KDE Web Account is associated with a KDE or district email address, (e.g., [firstname.lastname@education.ky.gov](mailto:firstname.lastname@education.ky.gov), [firstname.lastname@district.kyschools.us](mailto:firstname.lastname@district.kyschools.us)), you will be guided through the steps to switch to use your district email address and password.
4. After making the switch, use the *Sign in with Microsoft* button on the right-hand side of the screen. Note that this only affects users with KDE or district email accounts – Users **without** a district or KDE email account will continue to log in on the left-hand side of the screen as they always have.
5. This change only affects how you log in – The way you use your applications will not change.
