

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

**Family & Consumer Sciences Education
Kentucky Department of Education – Office of Career and Technical Education**

and

**The Early Childhood Education Program of
Campbellsville University**

In an effort to provide increased education and training opportunities for students, the Kentucky Department of Education and Campbellsville University have agreed to cooperate in an initiative to provide a seamless educational pathway for secondary students enrolled in the Early Childhood Education career major. Specifically, the purpose of this agreement is to grant college credit to these high school students for their coursework and training at the secondary level.

Students will be granted Campbellsville University credit if all of the following criteria is met:

1. Received a career major certificate in Early Childhood Education.
2. Submits documentation, signed by school personnel, indicating all requirements have been met.

Upon successful completion of the requirements above, students who receive one of the following industry-recognized credentials will receive Campbellsville University credit for the following courses:

Commonwealth Child Care Credential (including the Certificate of Eligibility)

Child Development Associate (CDA)

ECE 111 (3 hours) Educational Foundations of Early Childhood


