

# ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Between

**Family & Consumer Sciences Education  
Kentucky Department of Education – Office of Career & Technical Education**

and

**The Early Childhood Education Department of  
Sullivan University**

In an effort to provide increased education and training opportunities for students, the Kentucky Department of Education and Sullivan University have agreed to cooperate in an initiative to provide a seamless educational pathway for secondary students enrolled in the Early Childhood Education career major. Specifically, the purpose of this agreement is to grant college credit to these high school students for their coursework and training at the secondary level.

Students will be granted Sullivan University credit if all of the following criteria is met:


1. Received a career major certificate in Early Childhood Education.
2. Receives a letter grade of "B" or better in the career major courses.
3. Pass the Kentucky Occupational Skills Standard Assessment (KOSSA) or AAFCS Pre-PAC Assessment in the area of Early Childhood Education.
4. Submits documentation, signed by school personnel, indicating all requirements have been met.
5. Submits documentation and work samples required for the Sullivan Exit Portfolio where needed such as: Curriculum Philosophy paper, Guidance/Discipline Philosophy paper, Lesson planning and Thematic Units.

Upon successful completion of the requirements above, students will receive Sullivan University credit for the following courses:


*ECE 133 (4 hours) Health*
