1S1/Academic Attainment/Reading & Language Arts

Numerator: Preparatory 12th grade students who scored proficient or distinguished on the End of Course exam for English II

Denominator: All Preparatory 12th grade students who took the on the End of Course exam for English II

1S2/Academic Attainment/Mathematics

Numerator: Preparatory 12th grade students who scored proficient or distinguished on the End of Course Exam for Algebra II.

Denominator: All Preparatory 12th grade students who took the End of Course Exam for Algebra II.

2S1/Skill Attainment

Numerator: Preparatory 12th graders who passed technical assessment tests

Denominator: Preparatory 12th graders who took technical assessment tests

3S1/Secondary School Completion

Numerator: Preparatory 12th graders who received a high school diploma, GED or other state recognized equivalent

Denominator: Preparatory 12th graders who received a high school diploma, GED or other state recognized equivalent + those who dropped out of high school during the reporting year

4S1/Student Graduation Rates

Numerator: Preparatory 12th graders who graduated in the reporting year

Denominator: All Preparatory students who left secondary education in the reporting year

5S1/Secondary Placement

Numerator: Preparatory Completers with positive placement on student follow up survey

Denominator: Preparatory Completers the previous year

NOTE: Positive placements for secondary students include those who responded as employed, pursuing additional education, in the military or in an apprenticeship.

6S1/Participation in Non-Traditional Programs

Numerator: Preparatory 9th – 12th grade students enrolled in programs identified as non-traditional for that gender

Denominator: 9th – 12th grade students enrolled in programs identified as non-traditional for that gender

6S2/Program Completion of Non-traditional Programs

Numerator: Male or female Preparatory 12th grade Completers in programs marked as non-traditional for that gender

Denominator: Total 9th – 12th grade Preparatory Completers in programs marked as non-traditional for that gender
