School Presentations: Of the Tuskegee Airmen

General Lectures - ACADEMIC YEAR 2014/2015

Scheduled from August 1st to May 30th

As an international oral historian, speaker, lecturer and a “voice” of the Tuskegee Airmen, the **RON SPRIGGS EXHIBIT of TUSKEGEE AIRMEN** provides student presentations about these gladiators of the skies. Presentations are available throughout the academic year about the 332nd Fighter Group, the first African-American aerial combat unit of WWII. These airmen are the recipients of the **2007 Congressional Gold Medal**. The following information will assist in scheduling an historical presentation.

- Schools are invited to schedule **Black History Month**, as well as other times, to bring us on-board. We encourage administrators and teachers to **plan early in the school year** to avoid schedule conflicts with testing cycles, spring and winter breaks.
- We provide a “kid-friendly” Power-Point presentation to “**school assemblies**”, or large audiences. We schedule one class period, to get our message to the maximum manageable number of students. We can provide multiple presentations at any given location (*usually two in the morning and one in the afternoon*) for grades 4 through 12 and at college levels. We will make presentations to any school (**public, private, Christian or special needs**). Prime show dates are from November through March.
- Remedial (PDF) master handouts will be provided to the coordinator of contracted schools which in turn can be locally reproduced for their students.
- Our honorarium (see note below) of \$400 is requested for up to 400 students. **Multiple presentation discounts are available**. Schools having more than 400 students will require scheduling additional sessions not to exceed 400 students per session.
