

CDIP/CSIP Timeline


➤ Key Dates:

- Currently – Look at preliminary data for writing GAP goals in compliance with KRS 158.649 for October 1 reporting into ASSIST
- October through December - Review 2012-13 plans and update for the December CDIP/CSIP submission
- November 1 – Submit safety assurances in ASSIST to meet SB 8/HB 354 requirements
- December 20 – Submit 2013-14 CDIPs/CSIPs in ASSIST and post on district and school websites



2013 Reporting Timeline

- ❑ August 2: K-PREP individual test scores (NAPD) (all subjects grades 3-8, writing at grades 10-11)
- ❑ August 16: Individual student reports with student growth percentile. *Note: EOC scores already reported.*
- ❑ August 14 - 27: Data review and cleanup in SDRR
- ❑ September 12: DAC training and Quality Control Day for system issues
- ❑ September 23 – 27: Public release of accountability reports via the School Report Card



Replacement Tests for EXPLORE/PLAN

- EXPLORE/PLAN phases out in 2014-15
- September 2014 last possible Kentucky administration of EXPLORE/PLAN
- A separate High School Readiness and College Readiness Test required by state law
- RFP to be issued for replacement tests
 - RFP to be issued in fall 2013
 - Selection to occur winter 2013-14



Superintendent Evaluation Timetable

➤ **Now-December 20, 2013:**

Board and superintendent discuss three components in open meeting

➤ **No later than December 20, 2013:**

Complete Superintendent Evaluation Diagnostic in ASSIST; upload board minutes documenting discussion of three components

➤ **Spring/Summer 2014:**

During summative evaluation in open meeting, discuss progress and performance on three components; complete Superintendent Evaluation Diagnostic in ASSIST; upload documentation



A Look Inside ASSIST (Next 3 slides)



➤ What does the Superintendent Diagnostic do?

The diagnostic is a series of questions to be answered that provide feedback on how the superintendent is communicating with his/her school board on the performance of student achievement as it aligns with the Kentucky Board of Education goals.

➤ What are the questions that will be asked in the diagnostic?

You will address the areas of : District Delivery Targets; Resource/Support Systems; and Facilities and Resources.

Next Generation Kentucky Education Network

KIH3 Update

- “First Wave” bandwidth upgrades completed (42 Districts)
- “Second Wave” in process; monitor potential bandwidth issues
- “Third Wave” all districts on KIH3 by June 2014
 - New Bandwidth Allocation model of 50 kbps/ADA
 - Next FY request is for 100 kbps/ADA (funding dependent)
