**CASEY COUNTY SCHOOL DISTRICT
DISTRICT FACILITIES PLAN HEARING REPORT**

A public hearing was held at the Casey County High School on April 25, 2011, at 6:00 pm. The purpose of the public hearing was to propose a new District Facility Plan developed by the Casey County Local Planning Committee. The Local Planning Committee (LPC) voted 10 to 3 in favor of the proposed new plan and the Board voted 5 to 0 to approve the new plan.

There were no public participants in attendance for the hearing. Scott Noel, LPC Facilitator, served as the locally-appointed hearing officer. Those present to hear the report were (14) LPC Members, and (5) Casey County School Board Members, and the Casey County Facilities Director.

COMMENTS

Kevin Stephens, Casey County Facilities Director called the public hearing to order. The hearing officer outlined the purpose of the hearing and the hearing procedures in accordance with 702 KAR 1:001. It was explained that those persons wishing to speak would be given the opportunity and that written statements would also be accepted. All considerations will be made available to the Kentucky Department of Education via the hearing officer's report. The hearing officer read the proposed new District Facility Plan which includes;

1. Changing the Long Range School Organization Plan to a PS-5, 6-8, 9-12.
2. Change all elementary schools to become PS-5 School Centers.
3. Priority 2c, #1, Liberty Elementary School will receive a major renovation with a gymnasium addition.
4. Priority 2c, #2 Casey County Middle School to receive a major renovation with additions.
5. Priority 2c, #3 Casey County High School to receive a renovation with a multipurpose and auditorium addition.
6. Priority 2c, #4 Casey County Area Technology Center to receive a Major Renovation
7. Priority 2d, #1 District White Board Initiative lists 170 classrooms to receive interactive classroom technology.
8. Priority 4, #1 Casey County Board Office to receive a Board Room Addition and a Fireproof records room addition.
9. Priority 4, #2 Construct a new Central Storage/Technology Storage Facility.
10. Priority 4, #3 Construct (1) pull-through bus bay at the Central Bus Garage.
11. Priority 4, #4 Construct a new Central Maintenance Shop Facility.

These priority construction items give the district a total need of \$19,594,368

12. Priority 5, Discretionary Item #1, Casey County High School to receive a new visiting team locker room. Construct Public Restroom at softball field. Conduct Master Plan of Sports Facility.

13. Priority 5, Discretionary Item #2, Jones Park Elementary to receive (40) additional parking spaces near Gymnasium.
14. Priority 5, Discretionary Item #3, Walnut Hill Elementary to receive (30) additional parking spaces near gymnasium and additional parent pick-up lanes at front of building.
15. Priority 5, Discretionary Item #4, Liberty Elementary to receive several additions such as; Stage, Art Classroom, Music Classroom, Resource Classroom.
16. Priority 5, Discretionary Item #5, Casey County Middle School to receive a Concession Area near gymnasium entrance.

The floor was opened to those who wished to make a statement. There were no statements to be heard or read.

RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that the new District Facility Plan developed by the Casey County Local Planning Committee and adopted by the Casey County Board of Education be approved as the District Facility Plan for the Casey County School District. A copy of the new plan is attached.
