SUMMER FOOD SERVICE SPONSORS SOUGHT FOR RESIDENTIAL CAMPS AND COLLEGE UPWARD BOUND PROGRAMS; TRAINING SET FOR DEC. 4

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – Sponsors are being sought and training is set for the 2015 [Summer Food Service Program](#) (SFSP) for camps and college Upward Bound programs.

Residential camps whose enrollment includes needy children are encouraged to participate as sponsors in the Summer Food Service Program, as are Upward Bound programs with qualified participants.

The SFSP provides nutritious meals and/or snacks free of charge to children under the age of 18 – without regard to race, color, national origin, age (within regulatory limits), sex or disability – from May until September when schools are not in session.

Qualified sponsors receive reimbursement for all eligible meals served and are reimbursed for program operating and administrative expenses based on the number of eligible meals served. To be eligible, sponsors must:

- provide continuing service to the community
- serve meals on a regular schedule to children or provide meals as a part of an organized program for enrolled children at camps
- show they are financially and administratively capable of operating the program

The annual training for new and returning residential camp sponsors is scheduled for December 4 at the Capital Plaza Tower, 500 Mero St., 23rd floor training room, Frankfort, KY 40601. Training will begin at 9 a.m. ET and end no later than 4 p.m. ET.
