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COMMITTEE ON MATHEMATICS ACHIEVEMENT TO MEET

(Frankfort, KY) – The Committee on Mathematics Achievement (CMA) will meet Friday, Feb. 21 from 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. ET at the Kentucky Transportation Cabinet, 200 Mero Street in Frankfort.

The Committee on Mathematics Achievement (CMA) was created for the purpose of developing a multifaceted strategic plan to improve student achievement in mathematics at all levels of schooling, prekindergarten through postsecondary and adult. Components of this strategic plan address challenging curriculum that is aligned prekindergarten through postsecondary; teachers' knowledge of mathematics; statewide institutes that prepare cadres of mathematics leaders in local school districts; closing the student achievement gap among various student subpopulations; and the early mathematics testing program under KRS 158.803.

The CMA is comprised of 25 members including the commissioner of education; representatives from the Council on Postsecondary Education, the Education Professional Standards Board, and the Education and Workforce Development Cabinet; a representative with a specialty in mathematics or mathematics education; elementary, middle, and high school mathematics teachers and school administrators.
