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GIFTED ADVISORY COUNCIL TO MEET

(Frankfort, KY) – The Gifted Advisory Council (GAC) will meet Monday, Aug. 25 from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m. ET in the State Board Room on the first floor of the Capital Plaza Tower in Frankfort.

Mandated by KRS 158.648, the council advises the commissioner of education, the Kentucky Board of Education, and the Education Professional Standards Board concerning the development of administrative regulations and education policy regarding gifted and talented students. The commissioner of education and the executive secretary for the Education Professional Standards Board shall submit proposed administrative regulations and educational policies relating to gifted and talented education and other administrative regulations that impact gifted and talented students for review by the advisory council prior to seeking approval of the appropriate board.

The council is comprised of 19 members including elementary, middle and high school teachers, parents, members from postsecondary education, administrators, coordinators of gifted and talented district services, and individuals representing local boards of education, visual and performing arts and the business community.
