TELL KENTUCKY KICKOFF EVENT

(FRANKFORT, Ky.) – Education Commissioner Terry Holliday will kick off the 2015 Teaching, Empowering, Leading and Learning (TELL) Kentucky Survey on Monday, March 2, at 10 a.m. ET in the library at Saffell Street Elementary School in Lawrenceburg.

Joining him will be Anderson County Schools Superintendent Sheila Mitchell, Saffell Street Elementary Principal Todd Woolridge, staff and students, Kentucky Education Association Executive Director Mary Ann Blankenship and representatives of the TELL Kentucky statewide coalition of partners.
