A covered shelter is also available to reserve for lunchtime.

Ticket prices for the play **and** Old Fort Harrod State Park are just \$7.00 per person with one complimentary teacher pass per every 10 students. If time does not permit to do both, visit Old Fort Harrod State Park and the Mansion Museum without the theater component for just \$3.00 per student.
