Use of Infinite Campus to create a student cumulative health folder in lieu of paper has many advantages. Electronic student health records are more efficient and health data contained in individual records can be tracked in Ad Hoc reports to evaluate effectiveness of school health services programs, appropriate use of personnel as well as generating reports for school boards and superintendents. School nurse rights to health office are granted by the district's technical point of contact administrator, also known as the Infinite Campus Web Application Administrator Point of Contact (WAAPOC).

Note: Before using any Infinite Campus product (health office) or self-learning programs, creation of a user ID and password is required. Each school district has a designated Infinite Campus Web Application Administrator Point of Contact (WAAPOC).
