


# Enrollment in Career and Technical Education

---

## KRS 158.808

- ✓ Enacted in 2007 by the Kentucky Legislature
- ✓ Required the KDE to establish an energy technology career track program
- ✓ Provided \$300,000 annually in grant funding (*budget reduction in 2010-11 to \$275,000*)




# History

---

## 705 KAR 4:250

- ✓ Became effective in April of 2008
- ✓ Purpose of the regulation was to:
  - establish a process for KDE to administer such programs and pathways,
  - approve grant recipients, and
  - distribute grant funds to local districts.

## The Need for Change in 2014

---

As STEM and other energy-related initiatives continue to grow in popularity and demand, it is recognized that new and emerging curriculums have been and will continue to be developed.

### Changes:

- ✓ *Removal of all vendor-specific language*
- ✓ *Reporting expectations from quarterly to semi-annually*
