Anchorage Public Elementary School Major Renovation to include; site development including repaving all areas, front drive drainage and courtyard sidewalk, window and exterior door replacement, door hardware (all interior doors, include sanding and sealing, re-keying), roof replacement (19 year non-sloped portion of the building), interior finishes and accessories (in original building lower level Middle School-6th Grade hall, annex building classrooms and occupational/physical therapy room including lighting, flooring, ceilings, painting and floor finishes in original offices), HVAC renovation (to include installing separate unit in room 216, additional units in Main Common Room, replace rooftop unit in Main Gym), electrical (additional electrical panels, circuits, plug-ins, replace old wiring in 1915/1920 sections of the school), new intercom system, lighting (new light fixtures in the Middle School section), new emergency generator, plumbing (provide sinks in all classrooms, middle school restroom renovation and kitchen hot water heater), ADA accessibility upgrades (signage, restroom renovation, doors and hardware).	56,501 sf.	\$2,098,675
