## Changes to the CIITS Report Bank will be guided by district response to survey

The KDE Continuous Instructional Improvement Technology System (CIITS) team is taking steps to refine the CIITS Report Bank to make it more useful for your district.

On Monday, Jan. 11, chief academic officers (CAOs) will receive a survey regarding the CIITS Report Bank. Please collaborate with your CAO to provide input for this

survey that is due by Friday, Jan. 22. Make sure you mark all reports your district would like to keep. We will use the information to determine which reports to keep and publish to teachers. We are also interested in your feedback concerning any other reports you would like to have created and published.

## Assessment data and updated reports in CIITS

By the end of January, the 2014-15 Advanced Placement (AP), Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB), Kentucky Occupational Skills Standards Assessment (KOSSA), ACT WorkKeys (NCRC) and Industry Certification (IC) data should be in CIITS. To access this data, go to the School & District Data tab, click on Pre-Formatted Reports and choose the year and assessment data you wish to view. To access the reports, go to the School & District Data tab, click on Report Bank, click on the plus sign next to STAR Reports and click on the report title you want to run.
