


## CIITS 17.1 overview

The latest CIITS version 17.1 includes some helpful updates to help you search for, evaluate, and utilize Instructional Materials. Some of those updates include:

Name Change – The name of the location where materials you have viewed and saved for use has been changed from 'Go to My Materials' to 'My Materials'.




Searching by Rating – When searching, you can now delineate by rating; highly rated items are given priority over unrated or poorly-rated materials.



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## CIITS 17.1 overview

- Look and Utilization – Displays have been changed to make it easier to view and explore, with improvements such as:
1. Basic actions (such as scheduling, saving, etc.) appear together in a horizontal bar.
  2. Copy (and Edit) will always appear on the right.
  3. Modifications are shown on the right.
  4. A new rating system shows Average Rating and the number of ratings are listed. You can hover over that online rating to see the breakdown and you can also click on Add Rating to input your own evaluation.
  5. Tabs appear only when applicable, and they enable easy access to Aligned Standards, Linked Material, Organizers, and Assignment History.
