CIITS News, a supplement to the KSIS & More newsletter, is focused on CIITS data quality. CIITS data comes from Infinite Campus, Kentucky's Student Information System (KSIS); therefore, it is important to know how KSIS data is used and the critical need for accuracy.

Assessments Update: KPIs, Renaissance Learning MAP, ACT, more

- Several new Key Performance Indicators (KPIs) will be added to CIITS and displayed in the KPI dashboard. In upcoming weeks, you will see K-PREP, Alternate K-PREP, K-PREP End-of-Course, College and Career Readiness, Stat 10, Student Growth (SG) Reading, and SG Math.
- Renaissance Learning will provide weekly assessment data and daily delta assessment data to be loaded to CIITS. The data will be available only for those districts that choose to complete the required data-sharing agreements. All superintendents who choose to receive this data will need to sign the data sharing agreement that will be provided and return it to CIITS Service Manager Maritta Horne at maritta.horne@education.ky.gov. Schools and districts will need to verify and correct student identification numbers prior to opting in to send this data to CIITS. Renaissance Learning will provide documentation and reports to assist districts with the data verification and cleanup process.

- (NWEA) will provide a weekly update to participating districts' MAP assessment data in CIITS.
- 2012-2013 ACCESS for ELL assessment results will soon be available in CIITS. Follow this path to view the results: **School & District Data module>Report Builder>Pre-Formatted Reports and on the Student Profile.**
- 2012-2013 ACT data was extracted from Infinite Campus and will soon be available in CIITS.
- The Division of Enterprise Data recently conducted a data-cleansing effort to review test results that had not been matched to students for select administrations of particular assessments. During this effort, test scores for several students were matched and published in Infinite Campus. The data was then extracted from Infinite Campus and loaded into CIITS for these students. Data files for assessments that have been updated to included previously missing student test results and reloaded into CIITS are: 2009-2010, 2010-2011, 2011-2012 and 2012-2013 EXPLORE and PLAN, and 2011-2012 End-of-Course assessments.

Student Data Tool Now Available

Schools and districts may access pre-constructed reports in the district Report Bank. Reports available for K-PREP and Alternate K-PREP include demographics, scale scores for grades 3-8 and Lexile/Quantile for grades 3-8.

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) reports are available and include reading scores by demographics, and math scores by demographics, subject and grade. EXPLORE, PLAN and ACT comparisons and analysis also are available.

CIITS District Online Lync Sessions

KDE staff will conduct online information-sharing sessions focused on the new features and functionality available in the CIITS. Districts may view the live Lync session or view the archived version.

The first session in this series was Aug. 22. Additional sessions are scheduled for Sept. 25 and Oct. 24. Staff will send Outlook meeting invitations to all chief academic officers.



CIITS/Infinite Campus Gradebook Functionality Enhancements

The process that sends grades from CIITS to Infinite Campus is disabled pending enhancements scheduled to go into production with Infinite Campus Release Pack E. 1334 on Sept. 11. In the meantime, districts still may choose the "Send Test to Gradebook" option when creating an express test in CIITS, and the information will be sent to Infinite Campus when the process resumes Sept. 12.
