*Answer: Yes, the Health & Safety Low Attendance code could be used for that day if school was in session. The district will need to maintain documentation relating to the threat.*

- 2. Question: If we build our calendars for 16/17 and then the legislature enacts that we cannot start until after Labor Day, do you see this as a problem? Couldn't we proceed and then just change the dates?**

*Answer: Guidance will be sent from KDE to school districts if legislation is passed that will change school calendars.*

- 3. Question: So, who pays for changing the first enrollment date? I mean if the legislature puts off the start of school until after Labor Day, our first day of enrollment would change. I think I understood earlier that if we set than and then need to change that, we would be charged from Infinite Campus?**

*Answer: Campus can generate a script to change the enrollment start date for all of your students. They will typically do this for any district one time at no cost.*
