

EOY Training 2014, Session 2.7 – Health Reports Question and Answers

Q: What is the exact name of the Health report we should remove access to?

A: Access to the Student Health Screening report should be removed. Users need access to the KY Student Health Screening Report to get accurate data.

Q: Will we be submitting reports this year or will they be pulled by KDE?

A: KDE will pull the data on June 30th.

Q: On the calendar that was just sent out, it stated Health was being pulled on May 30. Is this incorrect?

A: Yes. The date was originally May 30, but since school days have been extended in most districts due to all the snow this winter, the date KDE will pull the data has also been extended.

Q: Do our school health nurses need to run the KY Student Health Screening report and submit it to KDE by June 30th?

A: No, that report is for them to run to verify that their numbers are correct. KDE will be pulling the screening data for all districts and providing it to Open House.

Q: So by June 30 districts need to be running all those ad hocs?

A: Districts should start running them now to begin cleaning up their data and verifying their numbers. The names of the state published ad hocs all begin with “Health Audit” so they are all grouped together in the state published folder. The system admin should copy the ad hocs to a group the school nurses/health data coordinators have access to.

Q: Are immunization certificates still required?

A: Yes. KDE checks for a valid immunization certificate and the type of certificate-standard, provisional, medical or religious. KDE no longer requires districts to enter individual immunization dates. It is optional for districts to enter this information. Statute requires students to have a current immunization certificate to attend school so districts are required to enter the date of the certificate, the expiration date and the type of certificate.
