

BOY Training 2014, Session 2.7 – Gifted and Talented Questions and Answers

Q: If a student is identified in a previous school year, what identified year do you use?

A: If the student will not receive services until the next school year, use the end of the following school year for the “Year Identified” field. For example a 3rd grade student is identified May 30, 2014, but will not begin services until the first day of school August 6, 2014. The “Identified Year” would be “2015” because services will occur in the 2014-2015 school year.

Q: Are the State Published GT adhoc(s) updated?

A: Yes

Q: What documentation is needed in the students GT folder?

A: Documentation of Evidences, current and previous Gifted Student Service Plans and current and previous Progress Reports. There will be **Lync webinar training on July 30th** to review this information.

Q: Validation Access-If a school runs the report will it only show their school information?

A: Yes, it will only show the data that they have access to.

Q: If a student is identified in May to be served in 14-15, is the year identified 2015 since that is the end of the school year? When does the start date begin?

A: Yes. If a student will be served in the 14-15 school year, the “Year Identified” should be 2015. The “Start Date” should be the first day of school in which services will begin.
