Explore & Plan – individual assessment scores are now available in Infinite Campus. Please notify teachers and administrators in your district that this data is now available.

- As reported in the [2/9/15 DAC email](#), the Kentucky Department of Education (KDE) released statewide data from the September 2014 administration of the ACT Explore and ACT Plan assessments on February 9. Kentucky continues to use the same 2013 benchmarks in accountability. The benchmark scores for ACT Explore are English—13, Mathematics—17 and Reading—15. The benchmark scores for ACT Plan are English—15, Mathematics—19, and Reading—17.

ACT National Scores (2014-15 through December) – will be published Monday, March 2. *Note: National ACT scores will only be published to those districts that requested in 2014 survey.*

Kindergarten Readiness - 2014 K-Ready and Social Self Help scores will be published Monday, March 2nd to all districts.

End-of-Course and K-PREP - Modified scores will be published to districts on Monday, March 2nd. The modified scores affect a small number of students. KDE has also modified the K-Prep test structure so users can see the status of students who are exempt from within the assessment tab.
