Please be aware that the following message and survey were distributed earlier this week to all state district assessment coordinators (DACs). If you have any questions about publishing ACT scores to your district database, please contact [raymond.carter@education.ky.gov](mailto:raymond.carter@education.ky.gov).

As the District Assessment Coordinator, you are receiving this survey to determine if you wish to have ACT scores pushed out to your district/schools within Infinite Campus (IC) for the 2014-15 school year. You may choose state, national or both scores to be loaded into IC. If you are not the right contact, please provide the correct contact information within the survey and KDE will contact them.

In addition to the state administered (junior) scores for Spring 2015, ACT, Inc. will now provide KDE with national administered test scores five times each school year. ACT will provide files to KDE in January, February, April, June, and August. Typically, KDE can load these files to Infinite Campus and push out to districts within 30 days of receipt. KDE is providing this service at no cost to the district.

By completing this survey, you can choose whether to receive only national scores, only state-administered (junior) scores, or both. Please note that ACT may update/amend/cancel scores if warranted and scores will be updated in Campus if that occurs.

Please respond to this survey to indicate your district's preferences by Wednesday, November 26. As soon as KDE receives a response to this survey requesting national scores, the August file that contains June 2014 scores will be loaded to the district's Infinite Campus site. State administered (junior) 2015 ACT scores will be loaded next summer.
