Process Inbox messages were sent yesterday as a result of a new Campus tool that 8 districts will be piloting for the Spring Preschool Enrollment Count. The pilot districts are:  
Barren, Boone, Calloway, Covington, Frankfort, Floyd, Glasgow Independent and Jessamine.

As reports are published for use with the data integrity validation/certification tool, “data certification type(s)” messages will appear in the Process Inbox in all districts. Districts that are not part of the pilot can choose to ignore these messages. If curious, other districts can take advantage of this process and get familiar with the new tools.

Five new ad hoc filters were published to the State Published folder yesterday for use within the Data Integrity tools; these filters were designed specifically for use in this Preschool pilot. The adhocs can be found in the State Published folder; however, they are only intended for the Preschool pilot. Detailed information will only be available when the filters are generated within the Data Integrity tools.

Guidance on set up and timelines for completing the certification through the Data Integrity tools has already been shared with pilot districts. The attached documents contain detailed instructions on the use of these tools for districts that choose to take advantage of the new tools.

NOTE: All districts still need to complete the Survey Monkey certification of Spring Preschool Enrollment Count, including the pilot districts.
