The Dual Credit Scholarship Program established by an Executive Order of the Governor on June 28th, will require changes within Infinite Campus and new reporting to KHEAA by August 31st. **Training on this topic will take place on July 21st from 10:50-11:50 a.m. as part of [Beginning of Year Training](#).**

For dual credit courses to be recognized for reporting they must be properly set up in Infinite Campus in accordance with [KDE Course Data Standards](#). KDE will create a custom report to pull courses in Infinite Campus to help minimize the burden on districts reporting to KHEAA by August 31st. There are data points not currently in Infinite Campus required in this report; districts will need to make changes to course detail and/or add to the custom report before uploading data to KHEAA. These fields include:

- Local Course Name <must include following in first 9 characters>
 - Post-Secondary Course Abbreviation
 - Post-Secondary Course Number
- Post-Secondary/Dual Credit Scholarship Provider Code
- Lab Indicator
- Scholarship Participation Indicator

An additional data standard specific to the Dual Credit Scholarship will soon be published on the [KSIS Data Standard](#) webpage.
