The announcement below regarding a **potential data privacy risk** related to FDF documents was posted on Campus Community yesterday. Please share this information with appropriate personnel in your district.

Attention: FDF Document Process Change

1. Recent updates to Google Chrome's NPAPI plug-in and Adobe Acrobat Reader DC in Chrome and Mozilla Firefox browsers now cause FDF documents to download to the user's computer when they are opened or printed. These browser changes require process changes for users of FDF documents in Campus. As these downloaded files could present a privacy risk, it is recommended users locate downloaded files and delete them.

The location of downloaded files depends on browser settings and may also be affected by Group Policy settings implemented by the district. Instructions for determining browser settings and finding downloaded files will be provided through the Community. Users may need to contact their system administrators with questions regarding district policy for browser settings.

With the release of E.1525, FDF users will be notified of this process change via a warning message in Campus. Districts should take the .1525 release prior to the NPAPI plugin update, which will go into effect on September 1, 2015. The update to Adobe Acrobat Reader DC has been available since April 6th, 2015 and affects Chrome and Firefox users.

Safari Users: Please note that you will need to make a minor change to allow you to edit FDF Simple forms without having to download the file to your computer. This adjustment can be done for immediate use:
