Calendars/Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Day Event codes N: Non-traditional Instruction and Z: Health and Safety Low Attn have been added. • The Calendar Report has been updated to properly report these new codes as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ The new codes are considered school days and will increment the Days of School Attn Month value. ○ The new codes are considered instructional days and will be factored into instructional time calculations. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ N: Non-traditional instruction is treated as a regular day and outputs a value of N for Non-traditional. ▪ Z: Health and Safety Low Attn is treated as a regular day and outputs a value of R for Regular.

Campus Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The header of Campus Instruction has been updated to include the teacher full name, rather than just the first name.
Campus Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a learning object is reassigned to a user, the previously assigned learning object will be reactivated, rather than a new one assigned.
Census	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modify sub-rights for the Local Student Number field and the Local Staff Number field are now available. These fields display on the Demographics tab.

Scheduling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • New Course Display Options have been added to the Request Batch Report editor, allowing users to determine how requests are grouped - as Required, Elective or Alternate, or as Requested or Alternate. • A new Report Comments field has also been added, allowing users to enter text that displays on each report.
Security	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A new tool called Student Link has been created. This tool allows system administrators to link all Campus student or staff accounts to LDAP accounts for a specific calendar or school. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Only users with a Product Security Role are able to access and use this tool. • A new Tool and Calendar Right Access Report has been created which allows users to view a list of all users or user groups who have been granted tool rights for a specific tool or rights to a particular calendar. Users can also view a list of all users or user groups who have tool rights for a specific tool within a particular calendar as well as narrow report results based on RWAD rights. • New User Rights Summary functionality has been added to the User Account, User Groups and Tool Rights tab. This new button allows users to generate a report which details a comprehensive view of all tool rights a user has been granted within Campus and brings clarity to how the user has been granted these rights (via Tool Rights or User Groups). Users can also hover the mouse cursor over a tool right within the report and view how the user has acquired these rights (either tool rights or a specific user group). • Various updates were made to improve and enhance Campus Digital Repository security, performance, and infrastructure.
Transcript	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A new option to group transcript information by year has been added to the Report Preferences Transcript options. When the Group by Year option is selected, transcript data is grouped by the school year in which the course was taken.

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
