System Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The State Classification field on the School tab is now a state-owned field. This means only users within a Kentucky State Edition of Campus are able to modify State Classification values on the School tab. Modifications made to State Classification values are automatically published down to districts. <i>Path: System Administration > Resources > School Pack: E.1406</i>
Ad Hoc Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ad hoc fields have been added for the fields on the following document editors: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conference Summary - Evaluation, Basis for ARC Decisions, Reevaluation Plan, Placement Options and Discussion Conference Summary - Initial – ARC, Basis for ARC Decisions, Initial Evaluation, IEP – Education Plan, Accommodations of Assessments, Transition Services Needs (14), PostSecondary Goal(s) Transition Services (16) Goals and Objectives, Present Levels <p><i>Path: Ad hoc Reporting > Filter Designer</i></p>
State Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Growth Factor R4, SAAR R7 and SAAR R9 reports were incorrectly generating a blank page as the first page of the report due to header issues for schools with 9 or more grade levels. This has been corrected. <i>Path: KY State Reporting > Growth Factor, SAAR R9, SAAR R7 Pack: E.1406</i>
Ad Hoc Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Enrolled Days ad hoc field (Attendance > KY Official Attendance Summary) was incorrectly including No Show enrollment records in reported data. This has been corrected. <p>Also, a typo in a java file was causing the Attendance Profile to not show all records for some students who have attendance records in multiple calendars on the same date. This has been corrected.</p> <p><i>Path: Ad Hoc Reporting > Filter Designer > Attendance > KY Official Attendance Summary; Student Information > General > Attendance > Attendance Profile</i></p>
ILPA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A new module called ILPA has been added for Kentucky districts. This module is used to record data for students participating in alternative education programs and includes a version of the tools found in other modules such as Special Ed and PLP. Setup tools in System Administration have also been added. Ad hoc fields have also been added for reporting on this data. <p>In support of this enhancement, Anticipated Transition and Placement Reason have been added to the Caseload, as well as various updates found in External Testing.</p> <p><i>Path: Student Information > ILPA</i></p>
State Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> An additional warning report has been added to the Preschool Enrollment Count which indicates all students who have multiple preschool service records where Start Date and Setting are identical. <i>Path: KY State Reporting > Preschool Enrollment Count</i>
Core Product Highlights	
Ad hoc Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Selection Editor has been updated to allow the use of the Census/Staff data type. This allows users to choose school personnel, parents and students, as well as other person records entered into Campus, when using the Selection Editor.

	<p>Path: Ad hoc Reporting > Selection Editor</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Users were experiencing time out issues when generating an ad hoc filter that contained one field when only one calendar was selected. This has been corrected. <p>Path: Ad hoc Reporting > Filter Designer</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When users were not assigned tool rights to course, they could not use the Ad hoc Selection Editor for non-course based filters. This has been corrected. Student-based selection editors do not require tool rights to Course. Also, filters that are saved by users who are not part of any user group now save with the user's userID for security purposes. <p>Path: Ad hoc Reporting > Filter Designer > Selection Editor</p>
Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Attendance Register Report has been modified to correctly sort student data alphabetically throughout the entire report. <p>Path: Attendance > Reports > Register > Student Daily Attendance</p>
Behavior	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Users were unable to save behavior records using Internet Explorer 9. This has been corrected. <p>Path: Behavior > Behavior Management</p>
Census	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When searching for a student using Student Search capabilities or the Census Wizard, birth dates were no longer displaying as part of the search result or in the hover text. This has been corrected. <p>Path: Census > Census Wizard, Search</p>
Custom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Certain custom tabs were not displayed when users attempted to navigate to the specified location. This affected custom tabs attached to Special Education, Health, PLP, ALP and Counseling within the Student Information module. Also, the droplist values representing these tools were all displaying as "General" in the custom tab Person Tabset dropdown field, and did not indicate the name of the associated tool. Both issues have been fixed. No data has been lost. <p>Path: System Administration > Custom > Custom Tabs</p>
Digital Repository	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Multiple updates have been made to the Campus Digital Repository, the cloud-based digital storage system used within Campus. Under the new Terms of Service, your district is allowed 1MB of storage space per student at no cost. The student count used is your state reported student number. Read the Terms of Service to see additional costs for using space beyond your free amount. <p>To help you monitor your district's available space on the CDR, Campus now includes a status bar in the Campus Digital Repository Preferences tool that visually represents your district's used and unused space as well as any overages. If your district is using more than 75% of its allocated space, Campus sends an alert to the process inbox for any user who has tool rights to the CDR Preferences tool. You can manage the space utilization and allocation for your district within the CDR Preferences tool.</p> <p>The Cache Size and Max File Size are now set on the Digital Repository tab in the Preferences tool. (Previously, these options were available on the Instruction tab.)</p> <p>Path: System Administration > Digital Repository</p>
Enrollments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Users reported receiving an error message when attempting to roll forward enrollments using the Enrollment Roll Forward wizard. This has been corrected. <p>Path: System Administration > Student > Enrollment Roll Forward</p>
Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously, invalid score characters were causing error messages to occur on the Portal, in Grade Book, and on grade-related reports. Logic has been updated so that when an assignment is scored with an invalid character, errors will not occur and that assignment will not be included in grade calculations. <p>Path: Instruction > Assignments, Grade Book, Grade Book Beta, Reports; Portal; Student Information > General > Grades</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously, a misplaced error message appears at times when viewing the Grade Totals section. This has been corrected. <p>Path: Instruction > Grade Book (Beta)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Several updates have been made to the Campus Instruction app currently in a closed beta testing period: <p>Path: Campus Instruction</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously, a calculation in the Grade Book (Beta) was causing performance issues. This has been corrected. <p>Path: Instruction > Grade Book (Beta)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The potential for slow performance related to deleting assignments within Campus has been corrected. <p>Path: Instruction > Assignments</p>
Internal Tooling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> As a follow-up to the Campus user interface update in Release Pack .1402, the following corrections were made: <p>Survey headers now display the current Infinite Campus logo. A cosmetic issue on the Days tab has been corrected.</p> <p>An issue with wildcard searching has been corrected.</p> <p>Internet Explorer was failing to remember a user's Campus Index location when returning to</p>

	<p>the Index after performing a search. This has been corrected.</p> <p>Help articles were failing to display correctly under certain scenarios. This has been corrected.</p>
Locator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students enrolled via the Student Locator tool who already have an enrollment in a different district were incorrectly being assigned a new Student State ID number. This has been corrected. <p><i>Path: Student Information > Student Locator</i></p>
Scheduling	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Scheduling rules were found to be duplicating when the Calendar Wizard was used in the Copy data into Existing Calendars and Copy/Append mode. This has been corrected. Scheduling rules will not duplicate when the Calendar Wizard is used in any mode. <p><i>Path: System Administration > Calendar > Calendar Wizard</i></p>
Transcript/Report Cards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> When a transcript includes attendance data, certain fields were being compressed, causing them to display with missing letters to fit the constraints of the editor. This has been corrected by slightly reducing the font size. <p><i>Path: Student Information > General > Transcript</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When the GPA integer was greater than two digits, the GPA and the Class Rank values appeared as overlapping on the student's transcript. This has been corrected. Campus allows for GPAs up to five digits; the new spacing takes this size into account. <p><i>Path: Student Information > General > Transcript</i></p>
