Reminder – Infinite Campus release Campus 1533.2 will go into production tonight. Details for the release were provided in the previous notification below and in the attached release notes.

This release includes one new and one updated custom report:

1. New KECSAC Membership report - The purpose of this report is to produce a quarterly Average Daily Membership of all state agency children served in A6 programs and A1 or A5 schools that serve Kentucky Educational Collaborative for State Agency Children (KECSAC). This report will be used to monitor accuracy of enrollments and KECSAC tab data.
2. Updated Teacher Course Check report - This report was designed to help with auditing Median Student Growth Percentile (MSGP) courses. The updated version includes course code changes for the 2015-16 school year and also allows users to choose the school year they wish to report on.

Special Education note: The release also reduces some validation required for locking the KY Evaluation and IEP. KDE is aware that this release will not remedy all of the concerns that have been expressed by local districts, but it will alleviate some of the issues associated with numerous validation codes. KDE will continue working with Infinite Campus to find remedies for additional concerns and continue to provide guidance and technical support to districts.

Course – Difficulty Level	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Difficulty Level code DC: Dual Credit has been added.
Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Batch Health Screening tool has been removed and replaced with the Health Screening Batch Entry tool. All user tool rights and user group rights assigned to the Batch Health Screening tool have been converted to the Health Screening Batch Entry tool.
Report Logic Updates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> IEP logic for the Dropout, Transition and Testing Roster Extracts has been updated to identify locked IEP documents when the PlanType.module = 'specialEd'.
School of Accountability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> New schools/codes have been added, reactivated and/or renamed.
Special Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Various updates have been made to the Kentucky Evaluation, IEP, and PSP based on state requirements. Additionally, the Caseload Summary and Process Compliance reports have been updated and new fields have been added to Ad hoc Reporting.
Unaccompanied Youth	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Unaccompanied Youth field has been added to Ad hoc reporting. Users can now build Ad hoc filters containing Unaccompanied Youth data for current and historical enrollment records.

District Administration for Grading Setup	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A new report has been added to the Grading and Standards Reports folder which generates a list of grading tasks and standards that are marked as post-only. The ability to define assignment marks at the district level has been added. The Assignment Marks tool allows district administrators, curriculum directors, department heads, etc. to create assignment marks that can be used by every teacher in the district, eliminating the need for teachers to create their own scoring system. The ability to mark grading tasks and standards as post-only on Courses and on Course Masters has been added. A post-only grading task or standard means that task/standard is used only for posting grades or scores, and NOT for aligning student work.
Calendars – STATE EDITION UPDATE ONLY	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Periods, School Months, and Terms tabs have been added to all State Editions of Campus. State users can now select a specific school within the district and view this data. These tabs have also been added to DIS functionality so that all data entered at the district level is synced and can be viewed at the state level.
FRAM	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> A new checkbox called "Include Current Enrollments Only" was added to the FRAM Letter Batch editor.

Impact Aid

- A Description field and Indian Land field have been added to the Impact Aid Site in System Administration.
- The Code field must be 10 characters in length exactly. Validations have been added if it does not meet these requirements.
- A Legal Description field has been added to the Address Info tab.
- These new fields are also available in Ad hoc Reporting, and do not display if the System Preference for tracking Impact Aid is not turned on.

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
