Report Card Preferences	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Report Display Name field has been added to the Report Card Preferences list for both Conventional and Standards-Based Report Cards. <p>When this field is populated, the text in the field overwrites the hard-coded value of Report Card that prints below the student's name. If the field is not populated, the hard-coded value of Report Card prints.</p>
