Campus Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Section Summary Report has been updated to include final and in progress grades for tasks with no assignments when composite grading is used. • Various updates have been made to increase the accessibility of Campus Instruction, especially in keyboard navigation. • Updates have been made to correct issues with printing assignments when tables, images, and lists are included in the WYSIWYG editors. • Corrected issue where scrolling through student names column in the Grade Book scrolled names only and not scores. • The options to filter the Grade Book to a single student or assignment have been updated to make it easier to remove the filter. Additionally, filtering the Grade Book to a single student has been updated to function correctly. • Corrected issue where assignments were being marked as drafts in the database incorrectly, which hid them from the Grade Book. • Corrected issue where teachers received an error upon opening the Grade Book if a standard had been removed from the section that already had scores attached. • The setting to use canned comments has been moved from the Grade Book Settings menu to Account Settings. Census	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Legal Name and Gender Fields added in the Campus.1537 Release Pack have been modified to make the use of these tools more clear. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Legal name and gender fields no longer appear on the Demographics, Student Locator or My Data tools. ○ A new Protected Identity Information section has been added on the Identities tab to house the legal name and gender fields. This area expands or collapses to display the fields and any data in them. ○ Tool rights have been added to control the school and district staff who need access to view or modify data in these fields. Assigned tool rights also affect the use of these fields in Ad hoc Reporting. ○ If any legal field is populated, the legal first name, legal last name and legal gender fields MUST be populated. The missing fields are highlighted to indicate data is required upon saving. ○ If Human Resources is enabled, additional validations exist, especially when the student may also be a staff member (or a staff member was a former student). ○ The Census Verification Report reports student names from the core name and gender fields, and not the legal name and gender fields.
State Edition/Combine Student	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When using Combine Person tool in State Edition for two people who have the same State ID, same last name, same first name, but different person IDs, those two person display as two different person records based off of the associated person ID. • When using the Combine Person tool in a State Edition for two people who have the same Staff State ID, same last name, same first name, but different person IDs, those two persons display as two different person records based off their associated person ID.
Student Locator	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Corrected issue where returning students could not be found using the Student Locator when the student name contained an apostrophe.
Transcript	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Transcript Report Preferences <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Grade Level Options - When all transcript course records for a school are from a grade level marked as Exclude from GPA/Class Rank, the school name does not print. ○ Credit Summary - New options for displaying credit group totals have been added to the Report

	Preferences for Transcripts. To include a grand total of credits on the transcript, choose Display the Grand Total for all Credit Groups option. Or, to only show totals for each selected credit group, choose the Do not Display the Grand Total for all Credit Groups.
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
