<b>Infinite Campus Release Highlights – Campus.1601</b>	
<b>Kentucky Specific</b>	
<b>eTranscript – PESC Mapping</b>	<p>The following modifications have been made to Credit Types included in eTranscripts:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The Credit Type for the TranscriptCredits associated with the course must be mapped to a PESC Name, done in the Grading and Standards Credit Groups tool. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◦ If a Transcript Course Record is for a course that has one Credit Type that is mapped to a PESC Name and one or more Credit Types that are not mapped to a PESC Name, one Course record on the eTranscript reports for the Credit Type that is mapped. Course Records do not report for the Credit Types that are not mapped.</li> <li>◦ If a Transcript Course Record is for a course that has multiple Credit Types mapped to a PESC Name (the same or different Names), a Course Record reports in the eTranscript for each Course/Credit Type combination.</li> <li>◦ If a Transcript Course Record is for a course that has one or more Credit Types, none of which are mapped to a PESC Name, no Course records report in the eTranscript for that Course.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> <p><b>KENTUCKY ONLY</b></p> <p>The High School Credit Summary node in the KY eTranscript looks at the Calendar grade levels when it determines which credits are counted.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If there is a course with a credit that is mapped to a PESC Name, but the courses/credits are from a grade level that is not included</li> </ul>

	<p>in the Calendar, that credit will not be included in the High School Credit Summary in the eTranscript.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the Grade Level is included in the Calendar, the credits from the course are included in the High School Credit Summary even if the Grade is checked as "Exclude from GPA/Class Rank calculations."</li> </ul>
<b>Special Education</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• New 2016 print formats have been added for the IEP, Evaluation, and Conference Summary. Various updates have been made with each of these formats based on state requirements.</li> <li>• Corrected issue where the Student Records Transfer and National Records Exchange tools were failing to transfer KY EvalEditor Status data.</li> <li>• Three new FDFs have been added for Kentucky, with interactive and blank versions of each: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Medicaid Annual Parent Notification</li> <li>○ Medicaid Annual Parent Notification - Spanish</li> <li>○ KY Manifestation Determination</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

<b>Grading &amp; Standards</b>	<p>Additional enhancements and tools have been added that allow curriculum directors the ability to set up certain grading information on courses and course masters that teachers can use when grading assignments and term grades.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ A new <b>Categories</b> tab has been added to the Course and Course Masters toolsets.</li> <li>○ A <b>Grade Calc Options</b> tab has been added to the Course and Course Masters toolsets. Because of this, the <b>Composite Grading</b> tab has been removed from the Courses toolset.</li> <li>○ A new Campus Instruction sub-tool rights has been added, called <b>Edit Categories</b>. The sub-tool right for <b>Edit Composite Grades</b> has been renamed <b>Edit Grade Calc Options and Composite Grades</b>. This renaming has only been made to the user interface; the database details have not been renamed.</li> <li>○ A new <b>Push to Courses</b> button has been added to the Course Master Info tab. This option pushes all of the changes made in the Course Master to all of the courses and course sections.</li> <li>○ Additional field locking options have been added to the <b>Course Catalog</b>.</li> <li>• It is imperative that Categories and Grade Calculation Options NOT be modified on the current or past school year calendar. It will adversely affect any existing grades that have posted and any assignments that have been scored to date. When the new school year calendars for 2016-17 are created, set up new Categories and Grade Calculation Options in that calendar only.</li> </ul>
<b>Records Transfer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Corrected issue: If a failed records request never reached the releasing district, the requesting district was unable to submit additional requests, preventing them from using the Student</li> </ul>
