Special Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Two manual scripts will run to clean up data for IEPs imported using the student records transfer process that were failing to print correctly. This case will update all IEPs created in this manner between 2/10/2016 and 3/16/2016 that have not already been updated. It will also revert transferred IEPs back to the 2015 print format. Note: Some IEPs may have already been updated using the work around of unlocking and resaving the document.

Assessments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Print function on the Assessment tab has been updated to now display parent tests and children test scores in order of most recent to oldest.
Calendars	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A Sequence field has been added to the Calendar editor and the Schedule Structure editor to assist in sorting of calendars in the Campus toolbar.
Campus Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Student Summary report has been updated to <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ correctly include all student-level comments when that checkbox is marked and ◦ display assignment details correctly when Grade Calc Options is turned off.
Enrollment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Tools have been added to alert users when a student is about to be enrolled into a grade level that may be incorrect based on the student's age. These tools are set at the district level. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ Administrators can enter a minimum age and a maximum age for each grade level, and select a date by which the student must meet those age requirements. (System Administration > Resources > Grade Level Definitions >

	<p>Grade Level Age)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◦ When enrolling a student, a warning message displays when a potentially incorrect grade level is selected. For example, if a third grade student is enrolling and the grade level chosen is 10, the message displays. The user can then correct the incorrect grade level or continue without issue. The warning displays where ever an enrollment can be added (Student Information > General > Enrollments, Student Information > Student Locator, Census > People > Enrollments). ◦ An Exclude from Grade/Age Validation has been added to the Grade Levels tab. This is marked when a school doesn't need to follow the standard grade level/age settings. (System Administration > Calendar > Calendar > Calendar > Grade Levels) ◦ A new report has been added that lists the students and the grade level/age exceptions. (Student Information > Reports > Age/Grade Level Exceptions Report) ◦ New tool rights have been added for the report and the Grade Level Age tool that must be assigned before access is given.
<p>Lockers</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Locker Location, Lockers and Locks tools have moved from the Resources folder in System Administration to the Lockers folder in System Administration. • Corrected an issue where a student's locker tab displayed the incorrect combination for a locker when there were multiple lockers assigned. • Locker assignments now track locker combinations.
