Two State Resolution Code Mappings Added and Safe Schools Extract Updated	State Resolution Code Mappings SSP7: Restraint and SSP8: Seclusion have been added. These resolutions will sync to the State Edition and obey the following validations: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a Behavior Resolution with a State Code beginning with SSP or INSR is selected, a Law or Board Violation value must be selected on the Event. • When a Behavior Resolution with a State Code beginning with SSP or INSR is selected, Resolution End Date and Resolution End Time values are required. Logic on the Safe Schools Report has been updated to accommodate the two new codes as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Resolutions with a State Resolution Code (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8, INSR) must contain a Start Date, Start Time, End Date and End Time to appear in the extract. • For Sub Report 5 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ All law violations not related to assault, violence, deadly weapons, controlled substances, bullying or harassment must have a state resolution of suspension, expulsion, corporal punishment, restraint or seclusion (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8, INSR) to be reported in the Safe Schools extract. ○ All board violations not related to assault, violence, deadly weapons, controlled substances, bullying or harassment must have a state resolution of suspension, expulsion, corporal punishment, restraint or seclusion (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8, INSR) to be reported in the Safe Schools extract. • For Critical Error 1 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ An error will result any time a student has a State Resolution (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8, INSR) without a resolution end date and/or end time. • For Critical Error 2 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ An error will result any time a student has a State Resolution (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8) AND no selection of a Law or Board Violation. • For Warning 4 – <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ A warning will result any time a student has two or more State Resolutions (SSP1, SSP2, SSP3, SSP5, SSP7, SSP8, INSR) which overlap by any span of time.
SAAR R1 Day Field Logic	Logic for the Days field on the PDF version of the SAAR R1 Report has been updated as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Report the total of O, C, G, P, R, E, D and H day events. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ R days = Instructional days with no day event or any day with an R day event
KY eTranscript Update for PESC XSD	Noted numeric and text default values have been provided where the PESC requirements and the Infinite Campus schema differed.

Behavior	Parent/guardian information is now visible on Behavior Participant information on the Behavior Referral and the Behavior Management tools.
Scheduling	A Sections to Build column has been added to the printed view of the Requests Satisfied Summary Report.
Grade Book BETA Updates 1.	Drop Lowest Score logic has been updated in the Grade Book (Beta) to refresh when a new, unscored assignment is added. Additionally, row highlights have been added indicating where the cursor is hovering or what row and field have been selected. A confirmation message has also been added indicating that grades have been posted. The following assignment status indicators have also been added: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hover text added indicating when a category is excluded from calculation. • The abbreviation of inactive assignments will appear in red text. • Scores flagged as Missing, Cheated, Dropped, or Exempt will have the score entered appear with a line through it.
Calendar - Validations Added to Calendar Grade Level Tool	When a grade level was deleted from the Calendar Grade Level tool, any enrollment records associated with that grade level were orphaned, causing students to not have the grade level field populated on their enrollment record. This has been corrected. Validations have been added to the Calendar Grade Level tool that prohibits users from deleting grade levels that are assigned to student enrollment records.
Special Ed - New Document Wizard	A notification has been added clarifying that no documents will be listed if there are no active documents of that type, which are created in System Administration. Additionally, the Create Document button will appear inactive if no document is selected.
Census - State Defined ID Field Added	A new ID field has been added to the Person Identifiers section of the Demographics tool. This field is available on a state-by-state basis and can be used for state reporting purposes or for further identification fields necessary for students, staff or other people listed in Campus. When the field is turned on for states, it can be up to 25 alphabetic and numeric characters and is visible on any Person Summary tab.
Assessment - Assessment Test Type Updates	The following updates have been made regarding the Test Type area of Test Setup: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Radio button functionality updated so that if a State Test and a State Code is selected, when District or National Test radio buttons are selected, the State Code value will be removed. • The National Test list has been converted from checkboxes to a dropdown list. • New codes have been added to this dropdown list: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ EXPLORE ○ PLAN ○ COMPASS ○ AP
SIF - Zones Tool - Exclude Schools With No Calendar Data Filtering Option Added	A new Data Filtering Option called Exclude Schools with no Calendars has been added to the Zones tool. When marked, schools with no calendars are excluded from the SIF SchoolInfo object and will not send information.

Care Center Tool Added to State and District Editions [Enhancement]	The Care Center tool has been created. This tool allows State Edition users to create and publish care centers down to DIS-linked districts for use within Early Learning/Prior Settings records. District Edition users can look-up and view existing care center values; however, all creation and maintenance of care centers are done in the State Edition.
New Consent Form [Enhancement]	A new editor based form was added called the KY Consent Form. This form describes the types of evaluations conducted and whether the student's parent/guardian gave consent for evaluation and special education services. The format of the consent form is selected in the Eval Types tool.
First Name, Last Name Added to CSV and HTML Version of ESS Report [Enhancement]	The Last Name and First Name columns have been added to the CSV and HTML format of the ESS Report. Also, the XML format of the report has been removed.
Special Education Plan Types [Enhancement]	Beginning in the 2013-2014, the date will no longer appear in special education plan types.
Evaluation Date in the Conference Summary	The Evaluation Date has been removed from the Evaluation editor of the Conference Summary and Conference Summary - Initial. In the printed Conference Summary, this field has been replaced with the Eligibility Determination Date, which reports based on the Date of Eligibility Determination. New print formats have been created for both the CSR and the CSR-Initial to preserve this field historically.
LEAD Extract Incorrectly Triggering Error for Primary Teachers with Secondary Teacher or Section Staff Record	Error 1 on the LEAD Extract was incorrectly being triggered for sections where the person in the role of Primary Teacher also had a Secondary Teacher or Section Staff member record for the section. This has been corrected.
Replacement FDF	The current Certificate of Attainment FDF has been replaced by the Alternative High School Diploma form.

ATC_CTC Center Codes Updated	The following updates were made to ATC_CTC Center codes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 105252044: ELKHORN CROSSING has been changed to 105252044: ELKHORN CROSSING. J D PATTON ATC has been renamed KENTON COUNTY ACADEMIES OF INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY
School Resource Office Field Added and State Resolution Code Validations Updated	The School Resource Officer (SRO) field (behaviorEvent.SchoolResourceOfficer) has been added to the Behavior Events editor. This field has also been added to ad hoc as customBehaviorEvent.schoolResourceOfficer (Behavior > Behavior Event > schoolResourceOfficer). Field 27: School Resource Officer has been added to the KY Safe Schools Extract and reports data from the School Recourse Officer field. Behavior Resolution validations have been updated as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> When a Behavior Resolution with a State Code beginning with SSP or INSR is selected, a Law or Board violation must be selected in the Behavior Event. When a Behavior Resolution with a State Code beginning with SSP or INSR is selected, a Resolution End Date and Resolution End Time are required.
Updated FDFs	The Speech Language Eligibility Determination Form and the Emotional Behavioral Disability Form have been updated based on state requirements.
Gifted and Talented Extract Removed	The Gifted and Talented Extract has been removed as it is no longer needed.
Core Product Highlights	
Health Office Calendar - Attendance Indicator	The Health Office Calendar now includes an indication of students being absent when they are scheduled for health office visits. A student marked absent displays in their scheduled time slot with the attendance code after their name. This allows the Health Staff to process the appointment accordingly.
Point of Sale - New Point of Sale Messenger Tools	The POS Account Messenger and POS Account Messenger Scheduler tools were added to give users the ability to create POS account message templates and send balance information and other routine food service messages. Messages may be sent immediately or set for automated delivery. New POS Account Messenger and POS Account Messenger Scheduler tool rights were added. Users must be assigned the new tool rights to use these tools. Review the documentation mentioned below for more information about these new tools. Preferences settings for the POS Account Messenger Scheduler were added to the Point of Sale > Account Maintenance > POS Preferences > General tab for districts that use Campus Messenger with Voice.
Messenger - New Option for Allowing Multiple Messages in a Single Call	Messenger can now deliver multiple unique student messages to a Student Messenger Contact in a single call in the same campaign. A new checkbox called "Allow Multiple Messages in a Single Call" was added to the Voice Settings tab for this feature. This option does not apply to Emergency Messenger. Emergency Messenger currently filters duplicate phone numbers when calling. The following issues were also fixed: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Fixed an issue with Teacher Messenger and the new addition of the WYSIWYG. Old Teacher Messenger only sent general messages or one offs and didn't allow Campus Insert Fields. When there were common Messenger contacts for multiple students, a message would only go out for one student. Now when Guardians are added, the student's Student Number will copy and the guardians selected will get a message for each student in the class. Fixed an existing bug found with inserting Recipient First Name and Recipient Last Name into Staff Messenger and Survey Messenger. When these fields were inserted multiple times into a message, voice calls would repeat the names in a random manner several times. This problem was fixed. Added an error message that displays when a user tries to save a Template containing a .wav file that has moved or been deleted.
Messenger - New Messenger Preferences and Editing Options	A new tab called Messenger Settings was added to Messenger Preferences. Use the Messenger Settings tab to configure the Portal URL and default delivery devices for new templates. A new tool right was added for this tab. Users must be given tool rights to use this tab. Users can now edit the Sender's Email field and Caller ID field on templates and schedulers. Users can control this new feature by setting Global Voice Settings on the Voice Settings tab or Global Email Settings on the Email Settings tab.
LEP	The Owner column has been added to the LEP Accommodation Types and LEP Service Types tools. This column indicates who created the service/accommodation (District, State, BIE).
