Modifications were made to existing core behavior attendance functionality to accommodate KY-specific needs. • The Audit Attendance Report was updated to provide the following three report options: Behavior Resolutions without a selected corresponding Attendance Code, Attendance without any corresponding Behavior Resolution, and Attendance created from a Behavior Resolution <i>Path: Behavior > Reports > Behavior Attendance Audit Report; Behavior > Behavior Management</i>

Diploma Types on eTranscripts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Local custom Diploma Type information was failing to be included in eTranscripts. This was corrected by unlocking the PESC mapping in the Code Defining tool. <i>Path: Transcripts > eTranscript</i>

Enrollments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The School of Accountability field was updated to reflect current school names and numbers. <i>Path: Student Information > General > Enrollments > State Reporting Fields > School of Accountability</i>

This was corrected. Selecting a specific grading task(s) only reports courses with those tasks. <i>Path: Student Information > Reports > Activity Eligibility</i>
Ad hoc Reporting	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Data Validation groups built on state published ad hoc filters were found to not be publishing to BIE districts. This was corrected. <i>Path: Ad hoc Reporting</i>
Custom	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Custom Outline Links were not using the correct external link when they were selected using Internet Explorer. This was corrected. Outline links will correctly forward to the entered URL in any supported browser. <i>Path: System Administration > Custom > Outline Links</i> External URLs visible in the outline were found to not be displaying properly due to the selection in the Pass User Session field. This was corrected. <i>Path: System Administration > Custom > Outline Links</i> An error message (selector.jsp error) was being reported when users attempted to open an external URL as part of a Custom Outline Link. This was corrected. <i>Path: System Administration > Custom > Custom Tab</i>
Digital Repository	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Document uploads have been enabled on the Academic Planning tool (Student Information > Academic Planning). Document uploads have been disabled on the following tools: Behavior Referral (Behavior > Behavior Referral) ILPA (Student Information > ILPA) <i>Path: Student Information > Academic Planning; Behavior > Behavior Referral); Student Information > ILPA</i>
Instruction	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously, the Grade Book was storing duplicate GradingScore records. This was corrected, and a script will be run at the time of update to clean up the duplicate records. <i>Path: Instruction > Grade Book</i> Previously, when updates were made in the Grade Book (Beta), the timestamp in Instruction > Preferences and the Grade Book Usage Report was not updating. This was corrected. <i>Path: Instruction > Grade Book (Beta), Preferences and Grading and Standards > Reports > Grade Book Usage</i> "Campus Instruction" was changed to "Campus Instruction Beta" across Campus to clarify the current status of this application. Various updates were made to the Campus Instruction application. Additionally, the following reports were added to Campus Instruction: Grade Book Missing Assignments, Section Summary, and Student Summary; Attendance-Attendance Change Tracking, Attendance Summary, and Attendance Register; and Roster-Portal Usage Roster <i>Path: Campus Instruction (Beta)</i> Previously, the Posted Grade dropdown that allows teachers to modify the calculated posted grade did not appear in the Grade Book Beta when there were no assignments associated with the grading task. This was corrected. <i>Path: Instruction > Grade Book (Beta)</i> Previously, when documents were uploaded to assignments, the documents would sometimes appear blank when reopened due to an issue with the Cloud Cache folder in the Digital Repository. This was corrected. <i>Path: Instruction > Assignments > Assignment > Student Work Product</i> Previously, duplicate database records were causing an error in the Edit Grade Calculations tool. This was corrected. <i>Path: Instruction > Assignments > Edit Grade Calcs</i>
Learner Planning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Progress reports have been updated to report Case Manager correctly based on the student's Team Members. The Case Manager who displays in the Progress Report is the active Case Manager when the Progress Report is generated. If a student has multiple active Case Managers, the one with the most recent Start Date will report.
Point of Sale	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Changes were made to ensure the Voids report populates the data and generates within an acceptable amount of time. <i>Path: Point-of-Sale > Reports > Voids Report</i> Class Serve was displaying an error when users tried to serve ala carte items after meals were served. This problem was fixed. <i>Path: Instruction > Class Serve</i>
Portal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Previously, an error occurred when using Course Registration on the Portal in Internet Explorer. This was corrected.

Programs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Modifications have been made throughout Campus to provide schools with the ability to plan a student's path toward graduation. Search	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Users were unable to view or access POS account search results beyond the first page via the Search tab. This was corrected. <i>Path: Search Tab</i>
