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Reminder – Infinite Campus release E.1501.2 will go into production Wednesday night. Details for the release were provided in the previous notification below and in the attached release notes.

This release includes four new custom reports and one report revision.

1. Teacher Course Check - This report was designed to help with auditing Median Student Growth Percentile (MSGP) courses. The report shows teachers in grade 4-8 and corresponding courses (local & state course codes). The final column indicates if the state course code assigned is a mathematics or reading course. For more information or if you have questions about the MSGP program contact [Jeffrey Coles](#).
2. PLP Intervention Data - The purpose of this report is to identify students with records on the Intervention tab in the PLP module. By default, all records will be pulled for students from the school selected in the toolbar. The year selected on the toolbar will not limit the records reported to a school year. To limit the results by date, you must define a date range by selecting a start date and an end date. Additionally, you may filter the results by intervention type, content area, and grade level.
3. CIITS Job Category - The purpose of this report is to show staff and their derived job category. A person's job category will determine the evaluation framework and sources of evidence (Self-Reflection, Professional Growth Plan, etc.) that a person will receive in CIITS. The job category shown on this report is based on the values selected in the Type/Alternate Type fields on the person's active assignment records. The Evaluation Override field is also taken into consideration when determining a person's job category.
4. CIITS Job Category Exception - The purpose of this report is to show staff who will not receive a job category in CIITS due to incorrect Type/Alternate Type setup on one or more of their active District Assignment records.
5. End of Course (EOC) Early Warning Report – revised to include alternate assessments. The purpose of this report is to assist school/district staff to identify students who do not have End-of-Course data. The EOC Early Warning report indicates whether a student has a score for state required EOC assessments. A student who has taken the EOC assessment will have an indicator of Y (yes). A student who has not taken the EOC assessment will have an indicator of N (No). A student who is exempted will have an indicator of E (Exempt). The report includes actively enrolled students who, on the date of the report, have a primary enrollment in grades 8 through 12.

<b>Course Masters</b>	The Course Master editor now includes the same fields that are available on the Course Editor. This includes standard fields used in every state (like Course Number and Course

	<p>Name) and localized fields (like Teaching Method and Instructional Setting) used in Kentucky. This enhancement includes the following changes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All fields displaying on the Course editor will also display on the Course Master editor, including all fields saving to Course and CustomCourse tables. The Course Master editor will display the fields in the same order as the Course editor.</li> <li>When a field is added to the Course editor (either through Campus updates or districts adding custom fields), the new field will automatically be added to the Course Master editor.</li> <li>Lock preferences have been updated on the Course Master and Course Catalog to allow locking for each individual course field.</li> <li>When a Course is being created, Course Masters are not available to use if there is already a Course Master linked Course created that is inactive. <b>Immunization Rules</b>	<p>Immunization rules for Meningococcal have been updated. Immunization rules for Tdap have been updated as follows <i>Path: System Administration Health &gt; Vaccines</i></p>
<b>FRYSC</b>	<p>Users were receiving an error when attempting to search for FRYSC Centers in the KY State Edition of Campus using Internet Explorer 8, 9, 10 and 11. This has been corrected. Logic on the FRYSC tab has been updated to expand the category when Born Learning Academy is checked. Additionally, the categories that contain checked individual interventions will now display in red to indicate the category has checked interventions, even when its collapsed. <i>Path: Programs &gt; FRYSC Center; Student Information &gt; General &gt; FRYSC</i></p>
<b>State Reporting</b>	<p>Effective Date logic for the IDEA Dec 1 Count has been updated to include a condition to check if 12/01 falls on a Saturday or Sunday. If no, 12/01 is the reported effective date. If yes, the reported effective date is the Friday directly before 12/01. <i>Path: KY State Reporting &gt; IDEA December 1 Count Extract</i></p>
