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Reminder – Infinite Campus release E.1513.3 will go into production tonight. Details for the release were provided in the previous notification below and in the attached release notes.

This release includes two new custom reports and one report revision.

1. *New G-code Validation High School Aggregate* – provides a count for each of the three graduation indicators (g-code end status, diploma type and diploma date).
2. *New Enrollment End Status Validation* – includes student-level detail records based on selected parameters to help identify potential data entry errors.
3. *Revised PLP Intervention Data* – updated report parameters to allow the user to generate the report for a single student using the SSID number.
