Homeless	Homeless logic for the KY State Reporting Import Wizard has been updated to include the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ When importing enrollment records, if Homeless is marked on the enrollment, the student must have a Living Status value other than null in order for the enrollment record to be imported. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Otherwise, an error of "Living Status must be selected if Homeless is checked" is reported. ○ If the enrollment record data is coming from a previous district and Homeless is checked and Living Status is null, the same error will appear and the enrollment record will not be imported.
LEAD	Population ID reporting logic has been updated on the LEAD Report so that if a student has more than one locked IEP, with a date range valid at any time during the term(s) applicable to the class section being reported, the most recent locked IEP will determine the Population ID reported.
Home Language	Language code 0275: Chichewa has been added.
Preschool	The following updates were made to the Preschool Enrollment Count Detail Report: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students with a Preschool Type of Head Start Enhanced will no longer be included in the report. ▪ Students with a Preschool Setting of 03: Head Start will no longer be included in the report. ▪ Users can now generate the report for previous years.
