Special Education Note: This release contains a significant redesign of special education (SPED) documents. Updated data standards are in final review and will be posted within a few days. An overview of the redesigned functionality will be presented as part of the KDE 2016-17 Beginning-of-Year training on July 20. The Division of Learning Services is also conducting live regional training during July. This checkbox can be used to exclude the marked record from being shared with an external LMS system, such as through OneRoster or a custom district configuration. This checkbox has been added to the following tools: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Scheduling > Courses > Course, Section ○ Grading & Standards > Course Master > Course Master Info ○ Census > People > District Assignments ○ Student Information > General > Enrollments ○ System Administration > Calendar > Calendar > Calendar, Grade Levels, Schedule Structures ○ Grading & Standards > Grading Tasks, Standards Bank ○ System Administration > Resources > School
Grading & Standards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • District Management of Grading Setup - When copying grading tasks, standards, categories and grade calc options at the course level and the course masters level, Select All and Clear options have been added.
Response to Intervention	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Response to Intervention (RTI) functionality is now generally available for all Campus customers. (NOTE: KY districts are <u>required</u> to continue using the custom Intervention tab for the 2016-17 school year.) KDE recommends that system administrators remove tool rights to the RTI functionality to prevent users from entering data in the wrong location.)
Section Staff History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Section Staff History tab now includes Access Dates in addition to Assignment Dates. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Access Dates determine a teacher's access to Campus Instruction tools (Grade Book, Planner, etc.). ○ Assignment dates indicate when a teacher is teaching a section, and for the most part should not be populated (this is existing functionality). • Both of these date fields can be populated with future dates. • The Section Staff and Teacher tables have been archived and converted to views. State reports that reported from these tables have been updated to report necessary data from the SectionStaffHistory table.
