❖ ***Career and Technical Education Data to be Released Monday***

On Monday, the Kentucky Department of Education plans to open the Career and Technical Education (CTE) tab in the online [School Report Card](#). Included in this data will be:

1. Information on students taking CTE classes and earning certifications (Career Pathways tab). There may be interest from business and industry in this tab since many businesses want to know what schools may be preparing students in a particular area before the business chooses to locate in a certain region or if interested in forming partnerships with schools.
2. Federal accountability for those receiving Perkins funding (Perkins accountability tab) – only data from the 2013-14 school year is included.
3. Career readiness data on CTE students (CTE-specific CCR tab). Unlike the CCR accountability tab that attributes career-readiness to a student's home high school, the data in this tab is attributed to wherever the career pathway is taken (i.e., Area Technology Center, locally-operated Career and Technical Center, etc.). For example, a high school that may have a high CCR rate for accountability could have a lower readiness rate reported on the CTE tab if the school had a high concentration of students taking classes at the ATC.

Additionally, as part of the report card refresh, we will be updating one data element on the Financial Summary tab. SEEK AADA data was updated to use SEEK Prior Year Plus Growth values instead of SAAR values. We also will be adding the 2013-14 spending per student data to

the Learning Environment – Students tab for all districts and the state. It is calculated as the unaudited AFR current expenditures divided by the average daily attendance (no adjustments). School-level per pupil spending values are self-reported by districts and will not be changing.
