

# Infinite Campus: EOC Early Warning Report Quick Reference Card

*Release date: 2/11/15*

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**Custom Report: EOC Early Warning Report** - The purpose of this report is to assist school/district staff to identify students who do not have End-of-Course (EOC) data. The EOC Early Warning report indicates whether a student has a score for state required EOC assessments. A student who has taken the EOC assessment will have an indicator of Y (yes). A student who has not taken the EOC assessment will have an indicator of N (No). A student who is exempted will have an indicator of E (Exempt). The report includes actively enrolled students who, on the date of the report, have a primary enrollment in grades 8 through 12. To generate the report, select one assessment or all, and one grade level or all.

State required EOC assessments:

- EOCA - Algebra II
- EOCE - English II
- EOCB - Biology
- EOCH - U.S. History

*Note: All scores are as of July 15 of the prior school year.*

2/11/15 Update: revised to include alternate assessments.

For the Alt-Assessed students, the appropriate Alt-KPREP assessment will substitute for its corresponding EOC assessment.

- Alt-KPREP09 = EOCE
- Alt-KPREP10 = EOCM
- Alt-KPREP11 = EOCB
- Alt-KPREP12 = EOCH

**Report Sample:** The report will generate in Excel format.

**Suggested report uses:** (Once report is opened in Excel turn Filter option on.)

- Run report by grade level to ensure seniors have met graduation requirements.
- Run report by subject area and share with team leads to ensure all students have completed required coursework and EOC or are scheduled to meet requirements prior to graduation.
