The pre-registration acknowledgment provided by the ZIS agent when an agent is not pre-registered has been updated to provide more useful and informative message.

Also, three new Data Filter Options have been added to the Zones tool tab. The following describes each new option:

- **The Exclude No Show Enrollments** - If marked, enrollment records where the No Show checkbox is marked will not produce a student-based SIF object and the student will be omitted from SIF batch requests and events.
- **Exclude All State Exclude Enrollments** - If marked, enrollment records where the State Exclude

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checkbox is marked will not produce a student-based SIF object and the student will be omitted from SIF batch requests and events.

- **Publish Social Security Numbers in the-** By default, Social Security Numbers are not published in the StudentPersonal or StaffPersonel objects however, users can include this information by marking the following checkboxes:
 - **StudentPersonal** - If marked, Social Security Numbers will populate the <OtherID> XML of the StudentPersonal object in both events and batch requests.
 - **StaffPersonal** - If marked, Social Security Numbers will populate the <OtherID> XML of the StaffPersonal object in both events and batch requests.

SIF StudentAttendanceObject Requiring Larger Decimal Output (SIS-61795)

Enrollment

Enrollment Save Error (SIS-62315)

When user who did not have tool rights to a Homeless Enrollment field attempted to save an enrollment record, an error message was returned. This has been corrected. The following rules are used when allowing a user to save enrollment records:

- When a user makes a change to an enrollment and all required fields are populated and school and calendar match the enrollment, the enrollment saves when the user clicks the Save button.
- When an enrollment includes data from other portions of the product to populate drop-downs, text boxes, etc, and is required in the enrollment, and the user does not have tool rights specific to the other area but does have proper tool rights to save an enrollment, the user is allowed to save the enrollment record.
- The Save icon on the enrollment displays for all users who are assigned proper tool rights.

Fees

Fee Audit Report - Incorrect Totals for Online Payments (SIS-57023)

Incorrect totals for the Payments mode of the Fee Audit Report was printing when Online Payment records were included. This has been included. Note the following information.

The following logic applies to the calculations used when reporting fee totals in the Payments Mode.

- Any voided payments that are returned (canceled) are not included in report totals.
- Any voided payments that are converted into a deposits are included in report totals.
- Adjustments are not considered payments and are not included in report totals.
- Over-payments (deposits) are included in report totals.
- Deposits made when the student is not affiliated with any fee assignments and has a zero balance or a surplus balance are included in report totals.
- Payments made out of surplus balances are not included in report totals.

When a payment is made for multiple fees and one of those fees is voided after the payment is made:

- Generating the report for All Payments (Excluding Voids) does not include the voided payment. All other non-voided fees from the payment do still display.
- Generating the report for Voided Fee Payments displays only the voided payment. All other non-voided fees made in that same payment do not display.

FRAM - Verification Updates (SIS-61992)

- The Verification Summary Report was displaying **0** for all sections when there was no enrollment for a grade/program in the district. The report now reports data based on active schools and programs.
- When benefits are ending for a verified household, the canned letter was not populating the new start date or an "X" indicating that students were no longer eligible for free meals. Now, when using the canned letter for the post verification notice, the date and "X" indicators populate correctly when student benefits are ending and the eligibility is changing to paid.
- The Eligibility Effective date on the Verification screen was not displaying the correct date for No Response applications. This problem has been fixed.

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Text Messenger Removed from Outline

The Text Messenger has been removed from the outline. Instead of a separate tool, the option to send text messages is now available on all messaging tools for districts that use Campus Messenger with Voice.

For existing users, the following Demographic data was converted: If a person in Campus had the "Text (SMS)" tool selected, they will now have the new "Emergency" tool selected for the Text (SMS) Delivery Device. This conversion was done because Text Messenger pulled recipients using the same logic as the Emergency Messenger tool.

Message Designer Removed from Outline

Templates no longer require a separate designer.

Important Notice about Existing Templates

Current users who have saved Templates to a shared User Group will need to be granted Tool Rights to a new sub-tool right called **User Group Formats** after taking the update for Messenger Redesign. This new sub-tool right can be found under each messenger tool. Templates saved to User Groups will be converted but users will not see them until granted this Tool Right. This will not impact Attendance or Behavior Templates shared to User Groups because these tools already require the User Group Format as a right to share to User Groups.

- Added the ability to mass update the end point URL. This automates the update process for changes to the ShoutPoint API without users or Support having to manually change.
- Each Messenger tool now displays a standard user interface that includes an updated WYSIWYG editor and a consistent set of fields across tools.
- Each tool now has the option to select one of the following delivery devices: Inbox (portal), Email, Voice and Text. Voice and text messaging is add-on functionality and may not be available in all districts.
- The **Message Subject** can now be different than the Template name.
- The **User/Group** field was added to each Messenger so that users can save message templates to their user account or to a user group to which they belong.
- All email messages may now include email attachments. The option to display the field to upload email attachments in Messenger Tools is a preference set by the administrator under System Administration > Preferences > Messenger Preferences > Email Preferences.
- Added an Ad Hoc filter drop down option to further narrow criteria to the following Messenger tools: Attendance Messenger, Behavior Messenger and Emergency Messenger.
- Added a Toggle check box to the Review Recipients screen to allow users to quickly clear check boxes for all recipients on a page.
- Message Recipient Preview now includes (when part of the message): Message Subject, Message body, .wav file attachment name, email attachment name and Text Body.

Emergency Messenger Updates

- Email is now a delivery device available for selection for both Voice and email only customers. Email only customers must update Tool Rights to view Emergency Messenger in their outline.
- A constraint was removed that checked for an endYear based on the user's Top Menu School

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Year selection when pulling recipients. Instead, recipients pull based on active enrollments for the current date. This is consistent with changes to how the add-on functionality of Remote Dial-in pulls recipients.

Voice Messenger Updates

- The Delivery Device "Phone" was changed to "Voice" in each tool.
- Added the ability to send extension numbers to ShoutPoint and have the extension dialing work.
 - If a phone number contains an extension, recipients cannot confirm the call. Confirming calls to other phone numbers for the same recipient does not cancel calls to any phone numbers which contain extensions.
- If multiple recipients share a phone number but have different Delivery Devices selected for the same Messenger tool, Voice call confirmation will not cancel the Text message from going out for the other recipient.
- Added the following to be said after each Voice message when a live voice is detected, "To confirm the delivery of this message, press 0. To repeat this message, press 9."
- Messages are now Recipient based so that calls can be confirmed by pressing 0 and results in the cancellation of additional calls for the same recipient (excludes phone numbers shared with other recipients in Campus and numbers with extensions).
- Added the ability to send extension numbers to ShoutPoint that will work in the following manner: ShoutPoint will call the base phone number. When the call connects there will be a 2 second delay. The extension will then be dialed and the message will play after a 15 second delay to allow for pick up time. Messages delivered to extensions cannot be confirmed and will show a status of "Pre-connect" on Sent Messages.

Voice Messenger Log Updates

- Performance for the Voice Messenger Log was improved so that the page displays faster. If there are more than 1,000 records, a notice displays under the log window indicating the records returned exceed 1,000 and the user should narrow their search criteria. A progress indicator has also been added so that users know their request is processing.

Census and Portal Contact Preference Changes

- A field called "Secondary Email" was added and the Messenger Preferences were updated on the Census > People > Demographics > Personal Contact Information section.
- An **Emergency** column was added to the Messenger Preferences Contact Reason.
- For existing users, the following Demographic data was converted: If a person in Campus had any current phone numbers selected for any Messenger Preferences Contact Reason, they will now have the "Emergency" tool selected for that phone number with Voice as a Delivery Device. The email field was converted in the same manner. If a person in Campus had any any Messenger Contact Preference Reason selected for their Email field, they will now have the "Emergency" tool selected for the Email Delivery Device. These conversions were done because previously Emergency Messenger would pull recipients based on the presence of a checkbox for any phone number under any Messenger Contact Preference Reason.

Batch Set Contact Preferences Wizard Updates

- The wizard was updated to include the new **Secondary Email** field.

Remote Dial-In Updates

- Campus system administrators for districts that have purchased Remote Dial-in may now set up and manage the data export task for sending a contact data file to Shoutpoint.
- Recipients now pull in the same manner as Emergency Messenger. Parent/Guardian must have a Messenger Relationship (this is current functionality) and Parent/Guardian must have Emergency selected for Voice on the specific phone they want to receive Emergency messages on under Census > Demographics > Personal Contact Information > Messenger Preferences. Staff must have an active District Employment or District Assignment record and also have Emergency selected for Voice on the specific phone they want to receive Emergency message on under Census > Demographics > Personal Contact Information > Messenger Preferences.
- A fix was put in to enable the Remote Dial-In extract to pull correctly when a comma was present in any recipient's Last Name, First Name or in any School Name.

Sent Messages Updates

- The Sent Messages report Message section will detail the name of any .wav file (Audio File), email attachment file along with Message Body and Text body of messages sent.
- Sent Messages report will show a status of "Preconnect" for any phone dialed that includes an extension.
- The Delivery Detail information for Phone/Email column now displays phone numbers dialed for the campaign with the trunk code (long distance in North America) of "1" included preceding the recipient phone number.
- Shared Recipient phone numbers for any Delivery Devices attempted will display for each recipient, even if a specific recipient does not have both Delivery Devices selected on their own Demographics Tab. For example, Recipient 1 (R1) has Voice checked for a shared phone number. Recipient 2 (R2) has Text checked for the same phone number. When a message goes out, the Sent Messages report lists both a Voice and Text message attempted for both R1 and R2. The duplicate phone number will have an icon indicating the number is duplicated under Phone/Email column.

Other bug fixes/enhancements

- The Campus Insert Fields for "CourseName" and "TeacherDisplay" were added to Instruction > Messenger tools. Teachers can now insert these fields into the Message body or Text body when sending messages.
- The message body will now allow the characters of > and < without errors. However, these will not be read by TTS in a Voice call nor can these characters be delivered via Text (SMS).
- Hyphens contained within email addresses will now display properly in the Sent Messages report.
- Message Template Names are now limited to 50 characters. Users will be unable to enter more than 50.
- If a Dial Window of less than 30 minutes is entered on a template in any tool, an error message will display.
- Inactive Preferred Languages will appear in the dropdown list with asterisks across Messenger Tools where the "Limit delivery to contacts that speak" field appears.
- CallerID settings are no longer required to be entered for email only customers wanting to use any Messenger Scheduler tools like Attendance Messenger Scheduler, Behavior Messenger Scheduler, or Missing or Failing Assignment Schedulers.
- Message Builder is fixed so that when two or more filters are selected with Intersect and One Message Limit, students meeting the criteria in the household are pulled accurately.

The following changes were made to Campus and Portal Journal formats to ensure Family Accounts print consistently.

- Multi-patron Family Accounts will only print one report per Mailing Address with all patrons listed, based on criteria selected.
- Journals printed from the Campus Portal include the following updates:
 - District information is formatted as left justified.
 - "Food Service Account Statement for Patron Name" was added to the header for individual accounts. If an account contains more than one patron, the header states, "Food Service Account Statement for Family Account."
 - The number of pages for each Account Statement will report in the header right justified; e.g., Page 1 of X.
 - The font size has been increased.
 - The section Headers for "Patron(s) on account #xxxx," the Transaction Summary section, the Transaction Summary title column row, the Transaction Detail section, and the Transaction Detail title column row are now bold.
 - The address now fits in a standard size 10 window envelope.
 - Journals now print with the list "Patron(s) on account:" that includes "Student Number" from the Point of Sale > Account Maintenance > Account > Journal.
- Transaction Details printed on statements now list the patron on the transaction. The POS will only print once per transaction. This is a change from the old format where the POS Name repeated for every item on the transaction.
- Changes to the way the Deposit (Point of Sale > Account > Maintenance > Account > Journal) include the following.

- Deposits designated as Check/eCheck payments, the Transaction Detail changed from "**Deposit (date) Check# 1234 (Amount: \$12.34)" under Category to only "**Deposit" listing under Category, the repeating date information was removed and Item now lists "Check# 1234 (Amount: \$12.34)."
- Deposits designated as Cash payments, the Transaction Detail changed from "**Deposit (date) Cash (Amount: \$12.34)" on one line under Category to "**Deposit" listing on the first line Category and under Item "Cash (Amount: \$12.34)" displays.
- Deposits made from the Point of Sale Terminal include the following changes:
 - The name of the point of sale on which the deposit was made now displays in the POS column of the statement.
 - Deposits made via the Point of Sale Terminals Quick Deposit button, now match the format for Check and Cash based deposits made using the Campus Food Service Deposit.
 - The Category column now states "**Deposit" with the asterisk that appears on the Portal Food Service Account Statement.
 - The Item column now states the type of payment made, any reference # and the total amount of the deposit.
