

Ad Hoc Reporting

Ad Hoc Reporting Zero Results for gradeKGStudents Data (SIS-44234)

Ad Hoc was reporting zero (0) results for the gradeKGstudents field if the KG grade level did not match the NCES grade level. Mapping for the NCES KG grade level used for the gradeKGstudents field has been corrected.

Using a space as a Constant Value within a Concatenate Function caused the Constant Value to be stripped. This has been corrected.

Users were unable to edit or export legacy Ad hoc filters (filters created prior to XML filters) containing a percentage sign as an Operator value. This has been corrected.

Behavior Incident Title (SIS-56693) [Enhancement]

The Title field has been added to the Incident Management Editor and Incident Referral Editor list to help users identify incidents.

Previously, if a user had user accounts to both the Campus application and the portal, a referral notification was sent to both locations. Notification messages will only be sent to the user's application Process Inbox.

Previously, some Behavior fields added in the recent Behavior enhancement were missing because the field type conversion failed to execute in the database. This has been corrected.

Detention Tracker Updates (SIS-57313)

The following updates have been made to the Detention Tracker:

- Detention assignments will only list in the Detention Tracker and on the Student Behavior tab for the calendar selected in the Campus toolbar.
- If a student has more than one detention assignment and detention time is served that exceeds the first detention duration assigned, the remaining time will be applied to the next detention assignment.
- A detention End Time that occurs prior to the Start Time cannot be entered.
- Detention Time will now display correctly when the Start or End Time begins with a 08 or 09 or if *am* or *pm* are lower case.

Behavior - Adding Incident Titles (SIS-57812)

With the addition of the title field in the Incident List in the Referral and Management Tool, logic has been added to populate the Title field with the Event Type Name if the title is left blank when the Incident is saved. This auto-populated title can be modified as desired.

Combine Person

ID History Fields Added to Ad Hoc Reporting (SIS-52487) [Enhancement]

Student Number, State ID, Other ID, Staff Number and Staff State ID history fields have been added to Ad Hoc Reporting. These fields allow users to report and filter demographic information tied to a specific identifier, regardless of whether or not the student is still using the identifier.

Combine Person Tool Updated to Delete Dropped Person's Picture (SIS-54532) [Enhancement]

The Combine Person tool has been updated so that when two people are merged, the dropped person's image is deleted if the keep person already has an image within Campus.

If the keep person does not have an image saved within Campus, the drop person's image will be kept and used as the keep person's image.

The word "occurred" was misspelled in an error message displayed within the Combine Person tool. This has been corrected.

Combine Person Tool Updated to Properly Merge Two People with POS Accounts/Identification Records (SIS-58626)

The Combine Person tool has been updated to properly merge two people when both people have POS accounts and/or POS identification records. Merge logic is as follows (and is the same for both POS Accounts and POS Identification records):

- When both people have a POS Account/Identification record, only one record is allowed for each after merge.
- The keep person's POS record will be highlighted within the Combine Person tool and kept while the drop person's POS record will be strike through and deleted after the merge. Users can also select the drop person's record to keep and delete the keep person's record.
- When the drop person has a POS account/identification record and the keep person does not, the drop person's records will be updated with the keep person's personID and in the preview screen the drop person's record will be highlighted (marked to be kept).

Fields Reorganized on Attribute/Dictionary and Custom Attribute Tools (SIS-30417)

Fields on the Attribute/Dictionary and Custom Attribute tools have been reorganized to better allow for an increase made to the field size of the Default Value field from 13 to 255 characters.

In conjunction with the field size increase, validations have been added for the Default Value field to ensure entered values are in the proper format/data type constraints. For more information, see the [Custom Attribute](#) article.

Attribute/Dictionary and Custom Attribute Fields Updated to Display More Characters (SIS-53312)

The Detail Code, Detail Name and Detail Value fields found on the Attribute/Dictionary and Custom Attribute tools have been updated to display up to 15, 100 and 20 characters, respectively.

The Attribute/Dictionary has been updated to only display core attribute and dictionary items. Custom attribute and dictionary items are now only viewable within the Custom Attribute tool.

Performance Issue when Multiple Agents Subscribed to Event Changes from Logic Heavy Object (SIS-50295)

Performance issues were occurring when multiple agents (DIS or SIF) were subscribed to event changes from a logic-heavy object. This has been corrected.

SIF GZIP Header Issues and Campus Portion Removed from Namespace (SIS-56679)

When receiving 'Accept-Encoding: gzip' in the HTTP headers for a SIF object, Campus was responding with a gzipped message but was not responding with the 'Content-Encoding: gzip' value in the HTTP header. This has been corrected.

Also the Campus portion of the namespace in all applicable responses has been removed.

Pending StateID Causing DIS Person/Identity Error (SIS-57873)

DIS logic was creating an error when pushing stateID's in a "pending" status from state to district. To correct this issue, the following modifications were made:

- The Student Locator tool has been updated to ensure students enrolled from another district have their stateID pushed down from the State Edition.
- Students that have a stateID with a "pending" status will have their stateID updated when doing a resync of Person/Identity in the District Edition and the currentIdentityID will not be changed to null in the State Edition.
- Students with a current stateID of "pending" will now have their stateID updated in the District Edition when doing a resync of Person/Identity.
- Students with a currentIdentityID of null in the State Edition will now have their currentIdentityID updated when performing a resync of Person/Identity in the District Edition.

Issues in DIS Extraction Ordering (SIS-58262)

A DIS event was being initiated before custom data was being saved. This was causing issues with localized SIF extended elements. To correct this issue, all DIS events are now initiated at the end of an HTTP request.

Fees - Student Tab Performance (SIS-56701)

The Student Fees tab has been optimized to reduce the amount of time spent when accessing the tab, when saving changes to the tab and when making a payment.

Course Fees Wizard - Decimal Points (SIS-56858)

The Course Fees Wizard was not displaying course fees for courses that contained a decimal point in the Course Number field. This has been corrected. The Course Fees Wizard now displays course fees from courses with any character in the Course Number field and will also display the Course Number as it appears on the Course tab.

Fees - Duplicate Course Fees (SIS-56908)

Course fees were duplicating if the student moved from one section of the course to another section of the same course. This has been corrected. When assigning course fees, the dropdown list on the Course Fees tab only lists those fees that are not already assigned to the course.

When scheduling a student into a course, logic exists that will review existing fees assigned to the student and will add that course fee if it doesn't exist. This is done when using the Walk-In Scheduler or the Roster Setup tool.

Printing Fees Information (SIS-57262)

Printing fees information from the Student Fees tab or from the People Fees tab was not printing if an end date was assigned to a student's primary address. This has been corrected.

- If a student has an active primary address with Mailing marked, the address is printed on the Fee Billing Statement.
- If a student does not have an active primary address with Mailing marked, an address is not printed on the Fee Billing Statement.
- When printing the Fee Billing Statement from the Campus Portal, the Student Fees print view prints the name of the student only. The Family Fees print view prints the name of the user (Last Name, First Name) only.

Also corrected was the display of an error message when printing the Fee Billing Batch that contained voided fees. The error message will now display No Record Found.

Editing assignment marks' definitions was causing the Grade Book to display different assignment marks for scored assignments on each reload. This has been corrected.

A warning message has been added to indicate when a user enters a health office discharge time that is before the health office visit entry time.

Null Password Values Causing LDAP Parsing Issue (SIS-58531)

Customers updated to Release Pack .1238 and using LDAP to log into Campus were unable to login due to password logic finding null values within the password table. This has been corrected.

Attribute Default Value Data Validation Added (SIS-58747)

Attributes with a dataType of 'Special' will now have a default value field of a text box which will allow up to 255 alpha, numeric and certain special characters.

Locked attributes will now also have a locked default value field.

Attributes with a dataType of 'Drop-down List' will not have validation logic tied to the default value field. The default value is a text box that allows created values.

Grade Book Beta Updates (SIS-54383)

In addition to a variety of minor bug fixes and appearance updates, the following modifications have been made to the Grade Book (Beta):

- A Cut Score Color Coding option was added to the Setting menu which, when selected, will color code In Progress Grades as passing or not based on the Grading Scale settings.
- Assignments in the Grade Book (Beta) can now be sorted first by Category.
- Sort options have been added to assignments and categories to sort students numerically by score earned.

Progress Reports - Enrollment Context (SIS-16824) [Enhancement]

An Enrollment dropdown list has been added to the Create New Document Wizard for Progress Reports to indicate the enrollment to which the report applies. This also appears on the first editor of a saved progress report. The following rules apply:

- The enrollment selection defaults to the current active enrollment
- All current enrollments load regardless of Service Type.
- All future enrollments load.
- Past end-dated calendars DO NOT load.

Team Members Tool Rights (SIS-27359)

Users given only R rights to the Team Members tab were able to click the Fetch Classroom Teacher button and have the Team Members tab update with classroom teachers. This has been corrected.

- Users who have R rights to the Team Members tab can view the information on the tab and do not have the ability to modify any data.
- Users who have W rights to the Team Members tab can view the information on the tab and edit existing information, but not add additional information.
- Users who have A rights to the Team Members tab can view the information on the tab, edit existing information and add new information.
- Users who have D rights to the Team Members tab can view the information on the tab, edit existing information, add new information and delete information.

Uploaded Documents File Name (SIS-34714)

When uploading a *.docx document, if the file name contained a space, the file would not open in the correct program type. This has been corrected. If a space exists in the uploaded document name, it is automatically replaced with an underscore (_).

FDF Print - Error Message (SIS-49735)

When attempting to print an FDF from the Documents Tab, the security message "You do not have rights to modify forms" is displayed, but still allowed users to open the document and print. This message has been changed to

"To print a form, open the document and select print."

Locking/Unlocking of Plan Documents (SIS-52781) [Enhancement]

The action of marking a plan (education plan, service plan, learning plan, etc.) has been moved from within the plan editor to the action bar visible on the main view of the Documents tab.

Previously, when a plan was complete, a user would have to select the document and mark the Plan Completed checkbox on the Education Plan editor. This move eliminates the need to open a plan to mark it as complete.

A Lock/Unlock icon displays in the action bar for Special Education, PLP and Literacy (Colorado specific) Documents tabs. A user can select a document from within a year folder and click the icon to lock it. A lock icon displays next to any locked document, indicating the information within the plan is complete. If a document needs to be unlocked, select that document and click the Lock/Unlock icon again. Appropriate warning messages display as before when locking or unlocking a document.

This change applies to ALL Student Information Documents tabs. See the [Documents](#) article for additional information.

The following tool rights are needed:

- In order to unlock documents, the user needs R(ead) rights to Student Information > Special Ed > Documents > Locked.
- In order to Lock a plan, the user needs W(rite) rights to Student Information > Special Ed > Documents plan.
- In order to Lock an evaluation or conference summary, the user needs W(rite) rights to Student Information > Special Ed > Documents > Evaluation.

An error message was returned when a teacher in whose course section a student was scheduled selected the PLP option from the section roster. This has been corrected.

FDF Forms - Duplicate Records (SIS-57449)

Grade Book (Beta) Updates - Score Flags and Drop Lowest Score (SIS-57523)

The Grade Book (Beta) has been updated so that typing the keyboard shortcut, such as M for Missing or Dr for Dropped, will now cause that associated score flag to be marked, unless the abbreviation is a valid Assignment Mark or Rubric score. When a score of M is replaced with another score or the fill options are used to add a value, a pop up message will appear providing the user with options to proceed. Scores flagged as M (missing) or Ch (cheated) will count as a score of zero.

Additionally, changes have been made to the Drop Lowest Score feature to match the behavior of the traditional Grade Book. For the lowest score to be dropped, there must be at least two assignments scored. The dropped flag will be removed if all scores are removed for a student. The Drop Lowest Score feature does not apply to assignments Score with Rubrics.

These modifications were made to make the Grade Book (Beta) function the same as the standard Grade Book in these areas and remove calculation differences between the two.
