Numbers of students graduating early who are not CCR can be determined through this data.

1A	Recording Intent for Early Graduation
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Campus Path: **Student Information>General>Flags**

The Intent for Early Graduation (IEG) flag should be assigned to any student who has indicated their intent to graduate early by completing the intent form and receiving approval for participation. The Intent form must be completed and the student flagged in Infinite Campus no later than October 1st of the year of the student's declaration.

Flags: IEG: Intent for Early Graduation

Start Date: Date the flag will begin to display on the student's record

Eligibility Start Date: Date the student's participation in the intent to graduate early begins – this should be the date of final approval for participation.

End Date: Date the flag will cease to display on the student's record

Eligibility End Date: Enter an end date only if the student chooses to exit participation in the intent to graduate early.

Participation Details: Enter the Exit Reason if a student chooses to exit participation in the intent to graduate early.
