



After School Snack Point of Service for Area Eligible Sites

Policy/Procedure Number: AS-2013-02

Date: October 2013

The Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010 has allowed a change in the snack program. If you have already been approved to serve after school snacks on the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), you may expand the offerings to students who are a part of the school sports teams and clubs meeting in the school as a part of a broad, overarching educational enrichment program offered by the school. There is no requirement that you track the specific activities of these students, as long as you have been approved for after school snacks which include appropriate educational enrichment activities.

Procedure:

1. Each site must have an approved enrichment program for their After School Snack Program.
2. Each site will have only ONE point of service for the After School Snack Program.
3. Anyone may participate in the After School Snack Program, however, if they want to participate, they will need to pick up their snack at the approved location during the approved time.
4. Each point of service must have a tally sheet where a trained staff person will check off each student who participates in the program.
5. Only those students receiving a complete reimbursable snack may be claimed for reimbursement.
