*Effective suicide prevention in a school setting begins with faculty and staff trained to identify signs of suicide risk and know what to do in response.*

Participants will be updated on current laws affecting Kentucky schools related to suicide prevention; will consider their school's 'readiness' to address suicide prevention by reviewing policies and procedures; and consider appropriate identification, referral and follow up of at-risk students.

Learn how to effectively utilize the SAMHSA Toolkit to guide school suicide prevention team members in implementing a multi-tiered suicide prevention program in their school/district.
