Who can participate?

Any educator who has experience working with English Learners in grades 1–12 in a WIDA-member state during the previous two years is invited to participate.

What will educators do?

- Complete a non-disclosure agreement (NDA) and submit a copy of your resume or CV
- Review sets of test items for grade-level appropriateness of the language and content
- Fill out a form for each set of test items, answering questions about each item
- Receive \$25 compensation for each set of test items reviewed
