





Response Option	Response Rationale	
a. They settled all disagreements before ratifying the Constitution.	The student identifies that the Constitution was ratified but does not identify the compromise that led to its ratification.	
b. They did not agree to ratify the Constitution because of the compromise.	The student incorrectly indicates that they were unable to compromise and therefore did not ratify the Constitution.	
c. They agreed to ratify the Constitution because changes could be made. (Correct)	The student demonstrates an understanding of compromise by identifying how allowing amendments led to the ratification of the Constitution.
