

## Reading Grade 5 E

Before beginning task administration, please ensure that all conditions specified in the administration protocol (starting on page 10 of the Administration Guide Overview and Attainment Task Administration) have been met. Inform the student that the task is about to start by saying, "We are about to start the task, and I am going to ask you some questions."

All questions from this task are available for presentation to the student in the supplemental material Reading 5 E Attainment Task Questions for Student Use.

Explain to the student that they will be reading a passage and will then answer a few questions about the passage. Present the student with <u>Reading 5 E Our Sun</u> (<u>Reading 5 E Our Sun Picture Board</u> may be presented as a support for the student). Have the student read, or read to the student, the passage <u>Reading 5 E Our Sun</u>.


## Reading 5 E Our Sun

<sup>1</sup>The sun is essential for our survival. It gives us light and heat. <sup>2</sup>The Earth's sun is a huge star made of the gases hydrogen and helium. <sup>3</sup>At its core, the sun's density is approximately 150 times that of water. <sup>4</sup>The sun is 93 million miles away from us.

The sun is always burning, and its heat is extreme. <sup>5</sup>A very hot day on earth is about 100°Fahrenheit. The sun's surface is about 100 times as hot as the hottest day on earth! <sup>6</sup>The outside of the sun is 11,000°Fahrenheit.

<sup>7</sup>All of the planets in our solar system orbit, or revolve, around the sun. <sup>8</sup>It takes 365 days, or one year, for the earth to go around the sun one time. <sup>9</sup>The sun also rotates on its axis.
